First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. steering W.S.W. saw two Ships at 9 P.M. spoke the bark President of New Bedford with 500 barrels Middle part Calm Latter part fresh breezes at S.E. stood off and on betwixt Abhermarle and Harbours So Ends

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather Cruising of Harbours in Company with the President Capt. Dorens of whom we shipped A Cullard was by the name of Thomas Francis Middle part Calm Latter part moderate breezes and pleasant weather sun down about the mouth of the Bay betwixt Harbours and Abhermarle saw Capensis So Ends Land 4 Leagues Distant

Remarks on Board Sundayth 29

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S sun down betwixt Resons Brock and Abhermarle at 9 P.M. the wind very lite and the Current very strong setting for the Brock at 12 the Ship within one hundred fathoms of the Brock got the fourth cut to help tow the others had been towing one hour with out success at 1 A.M. Caught 10 lite breeze and got clear at 3 A.M. took up the Boats and stood to the westward at 9 were Ship and steared S.E. at Noon the Brock Bearing S.E. So Ends
