First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to E.S.E. Cruising betwixt James's and Bindlows Island saw Blackfish and Porpoises Middle and latter parts the same To Ends No Ob.

Remarks on Board Friday ^{the} 10

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S to E.S.E. Cruising betwixt the Islands saw Blackfish and Porpoises Middle and latter part the wind the same and the weather very pleasant Bunt the Cables and got ready for going in to James's Island To Ends all well on Board No Ob.

Remarks on Board Saturday ^{the} 11

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather beating up for James's Island Harbour Middle and latter part moderate breezes at 8 A.M. came to an Anchor in James's Island Harbour in seven fathoms water. sent two Boats on shore after Turpin and the remainder of the Crew Moved the Ship and other necessary jobs To Ends

Remarks on Board Sunday ^{the} 12

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather lying at an Anchor in James's Island Harbour all hands employed in getting of Turpin To Ends

Remarks on Board Monday ^{the} 13

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather all hands employed in getting Turpin which is not very plenty To Ends

Remarks on Board Tuesday ^{the} 14

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather all hands employed in getting Turpin and got but few Middle part the wind like latter part at 6 A.M. got under way and stood out of the Harbour with a fine breeze at 10 A.M. Calm and A strong Current setting to the S.W. To Ends No Ob.
