First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and thick weather at 6 PM spoke the Bark Ship President And the Ship Victory Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same Cruising of and on to the weather of I de la Plata So Ends Lat by Ob 1-54 S

Remarks on Board Sunday ²⁶

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the ESE the Bark President in Company Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 12 tacked ship to the westward at Noon one Ship in sight So Ends Lat by Ob 2-21 S

Remarks on Board Monday ²⁷

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and thick weather at 2 PM spoke the Ship Logan at 4 more Ship to Eastward and took in the Main Top Gellat sail and Breefed the Fore and Mizzen Top sail Middle part moderate Latter part strong breezes at 8 PM steaming to the ESE saw one Finback and two Humphreys So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 2-26 S

Remarks on Board Tuesday ²⁸

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and thick weather steaming SE by E at 6 PM shortened sail and steamed by the wind to the E by S Middle part moderate breezes and pleasant weather at 6 AM made sail and steaming SE the Land in sight Latter part the wind litle and the weather good same Breaches at Noon Point St Helena bearing ESE two sail in sight So Ends with ships Duty So Ob

Remarks on Board Wednesday June ²⁹ 1831

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at South and Cloudy saw Flumpbacks. Blackfish and Bananas at 6 PM shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same Cruising of Point St Helena So Ends Lat by Ob 2-0 S

Remarks on Board Thursday ³⁰

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at South and Cloudy steaming ESE the Land in sight at 6 PM tacked Ship the wind at 1 PM lay up. Why S Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 AM tacked to the ESE saw one Finback Lat by Ob 1-45 S

Remarks on Board Friday July ¹ 1831

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at SSW And Cloud steaming SE at 6 PM tacked Ship to the West took in the Fore and Mizzen Top Gellat sail Middle and Latter parts the same at 10 AM set the Top Gellat sails saw Blackfish and one Finback So Ends Lat by Ob 1-13 S

Remarks on Board Saturday ²

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and thick weather steaming WSW at 6 PM shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 AM made sail and tacked Ship to the Eastward so Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 1-17 S

Remarks on Board Sunday ³

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and thick weather steaming ESE at 6 PM shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind at 1 PM steaming by the wind SE by E the weather very thick saw Blackfish And Finbacks So Ends all well Lat by Ob 1-32 S
