Ship to the westward Middle and Latter parts the wind
and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked back again
to the S.E. saw Blackfish. Broke out the after Hold
and trimmed the Ship So Ends Lat by Ob 1-28 S

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 5

First part of this 24 hours moderate breeze from South
to S.W. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 10 P.M.
tacked Ship Middle and Latter part the wind the same
the weather thick and Cloudy at 2 A.M. tacked Ship
Again saw Finbacks So Ends with Ships Duty
Lat by Ob 2-25 S

First part of this 24 hours moderate breeze from South
to S.W. steaming by the wind to S.E. at 8 P.M. tacked
Ship to the Westward at 2 A.M. tacked back Again
Middle part the wind and weather moderate Latter
part fresh breeze at S.W. steaming S.E. saw Finback
So Ends Land 15 Leagues of Lat by Ob 3-18 S

by the wind S.E. at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the Westward
Middle and Latter parts fresh breeze and thick weather
at 7 A.M. tacked to the Eastward at Noon the Land
in sight 15 Leagues of So Ends Lat by Ob 3-39 S

steaming by the wind S.E. at 6 P.M. tacked to the westward
Middle and Latter parts the wind the same the weather
Cloudy at 9 A.M. tacked to the Eastward saw Finbacks and
Humpbacks and Blackfish So Ends Lat by Ob 4-16 S

Remarks on Board Saturday Julyth 9 - 1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze at South and clear weather
steaming by the wind to the Eastward one Ship in sight at 6 P.M.
tacked to the Westward Middle and Latter parts the wind and
weather the same at 1 A.M. tacked to the Eastward saw
Finbacks and Humpbacks So Ends Lat by Ob 4-23 S

Remarks on Board Sundayth 10

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze at South and clear
at 5 P.M. saw the Land at 5 tacked of saw Finbacks Hump
And Killis Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather
the same at 2 A.M. tacked in at day light saw the Land
at 10 A.M. tacked of at Noon Cape Blanco plain in sight
Distance 10 Leagues Lat by Ob 4-38

Remarks on Board Mondayth 11

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze at S.W. and
Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Westward Middle and
Latter parts the wind and weather much the same
saw Finbacks Blackfish Swordfish So Ends with
Ships Duty Lat by Ob 5-12 S

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 12

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze at S.E. by S and
Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Southward and
westward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather
the same saw Finbacks Blackfish and Porpoise
So Ends all well on Board Lat by Ob 5-29 S

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 13

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze and equally
weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail and tacked to the
Eastward Middle and Latter parts the wind and
weather the same at 11 A.M. saw A Spinn whale
Round the ^{windward} very quick got the Boats all ready to load
stood on until Noon and then tacked for Home
Lat by Ob 5-25 S
