

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1831

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E by E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 PM tacked Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 AM tacked ship to the Eastward Brought the Main Flood and filled some Salt water saw Blackfish and Finbacks So Ends Lat by Ob 5-21 S

Remarks on Board Thursday 4<sup>th</sup>

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E by E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 PM tacked Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 AM tacked Ship to the Eastward saw Finbacks So Ends with Ship's Duty too Ships in sight Lat by Ob 6-15 S

Remarks on Board Friday 5<sup>th</sup>

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 10 PM tacked Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same saw Finbacks one Ship in sight Lat by Ob 6-29 S

Remarks on Board Saturday 6<sup>th</sup>

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and rough weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 PM shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same saw Finbacks and great quantities of small Fish So Ends Lat by Ob 7-23 S

Remarks on Board Sunday 7<sup>th</sup>

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and equally steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 PM shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 AM turned one Reef out of the Fore Toprail saw Finbacks and Humpbacks So Ends Lat by Ob 6-29 S

Remarks on Board Monday August 8<sup>th</sup> 1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and equally steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 PM Double Reefed the Topmasts took in the Main sail and wore Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 AM wore Ship to the Eastward So Ends one Ship in sight Lat by Ob 6-27 S

Remarks on Board Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup>

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E by S and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 PM took in the Main sail and wore Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 AM wore Ship to the Eastward at 6 AM set the Main sail at 10 turned one Reef out of the Fore and Main Toprails So Ends with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 6-18 S

Remarks on Board Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup>

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 PM shortened sail and wore Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 AM wore Ship again at 6 AM made sail at 7 saw a School of Whales three points of the weather bore going to windward very quick made all sail in hopes to overtake them but without success So Ends one Ship in sight Lat by Ob 6-8 S

Remarks on Board Thursday 11<sup>th</sup>

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward saw Blackfish at 6 PM took in the Top Gallantails and tacked Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the same at 6 AM made all sail So Ends with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 6-10 S

Remarks on Board Friday 12<sup>th</sup>

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 PM shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 AM made sail saw Finbacks and Blackfish So Ends all well on Board Lat by Ob 7-36 S
