First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and equally steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail and tacked Ship to the Eastward saw Flumphbacks and Finbacks and Blackfish So Ends

Remarks on Board Sunday 21

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E by Land equally steaming S E at 6 shortened sail and luffed by the wind to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 9 A.M. made sail and steaming North saw Blackfish So Ends

Remarks on Board Monday 22

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E and Cloudy steaming S W at 3 P.M. saw 1 Ship to the Westward Bowed round the yards and stood towards her at 6 shortened sail at 7 spoke the Ship Swift of San Bedford Capt with 1500 Bowed the yards and steaming by the wind to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail and steaming North So Ends

Remarks on Board Tuesday 23

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E by Land Cloudy steaming S at 6 P.M. shortened sail and luffed by the wind to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts fresh winds and equally made some sail stood by the wind to the Eastward saw Finbacks So Ends

Remarks on Board Wednesday 24

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. reefed the Top sails and took in the Main sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. set the Main sail at 10 turned one Reef out of the Main Top sail and set the Main top Gallant sail So Ends saw Blackfish So Ob

Remarks on Board Thursday August 25-1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and Cloudy at 2 P.M. saw two Ships to leeward sun of and spoke them the Bark President and Bark Mennerwa Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same steaming by the wind to the Eastward both Ships in sight saw Blackfish So Ends all well

Remarks on Board Friday 26

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle part the same at 2 A.M. made Ship to the S W Latter part fresh breezes and foggy at 6 A.M. made Ship to the Eastward at 7 saw whales bound to windward quick put of and chased them but could not come up with them so came on Board So Ends with hard luck for Ships in sight

Remarks on Board Saturday 27

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes and rough weather at 1 P.M. tacked Ship to the S W at 6 shortened sail at 10 made Ship Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 A.M. turned one Reef out of the Fore and Main Top sail and set the Jib and Sparker saw Finbacks and Flumphbacks So Ends two Ships in sight

Remarks on Board Sunday 28

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and rough weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened sail three Ships in sight at 10 made Ship at 2 A.M. made back Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. saw whales put of struck and got one took him A long side and cut him in So Ends

Remarks on Board Monday 29

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and rough weather at 5 P.M. saw whales put of but could not strike came on Board shortened sail and lay of and on them the night Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. commenced Drailing at 11 A.M. saw whales put of and struck two and painted both times and the whales went of to windward So Ends
