

Remarks on Board Tuesday August th 29 - 1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and rough weather at 2 P.M. saw whales bound to windward very quick at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 7 A.M. saw whales to windward at Noon the Land 15 Leagues distant one Ship in sight So Ends
Lat by Ob 3-48 S

Remarks on Board Wednesday th 30

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the S.E. at 2 P.M. tacked Ship and spoke the Bark Menusca Capt Brice. the Land plane in sight from the Deck Middle and Latter parts more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail at 7 saw whales part of but could not strike at 10 saw whales a long way off to windward four Ships in sight So Ends
Lat by Ob 3-50 Lon 82-00

Remarks on Board Thursday th 31

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S by E and pleasant weather at 3 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 6 shortened sail Middle part the same Latter part fresh breezes and thick weather at 8 A.M. made sail at 8 tacked Ship to the W.P.W. So Ends three Ships in sight
Lat by Ob 3-56 Lon 82-15

Remarks on Board Friday th 1

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes and Cloudy weather at 1 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 6 shortened sail at 9 spoke the Ship Nuxena of New Bedford with 1050 Middle and Latter parts the wind the same at 9 P.M. and the weather thick saw Flumphbacks So Ends three Ships in sight at Noon the Land 10 Leagues distant Cape Blanco
Lon 81-36 Lat by Ob 4-12

Remarks on Board Saturday August th 27 - 1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy steady by the wind the Land plane in sight at 5 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. three Ships in sight Middle part the same Latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail one Ship in sight saw Flumphbacks So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 4-08 Lon 82-10

Remarks on Board Sunday th 28

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same with the addition of some fog at 10 A.M. made same sail three Ships in sight saw Flumphbacks and Furbacks So Ends
Lat by Ob 4-07 Lon 81-45

Remarks on Board Monday th 29

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming S.W. at 6 P.M. luffed by the wind S.W. by S and shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail one Ship in sight at 7 spoke the Ship Eric of New Port with 2000 Capt Adams unwell filled W-way and stood to the Eastward by the wind the Eric in Company So Ends
Lat by Ob 4-5 Lon 81-55

Remarks on Board Tuesday th 30

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward the Eric in Company at 2 P.M. spoke the President at 9 were Ship to the S.W. Middle the same Latter part fresh breezes at South at 8 A.M. tacked Ship to the S.E. at Noon two Ships in sight So Ends
Lat by Ob 4-16 Lon 81-45

Remarks on Board Wednesday th 31

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes and Cloudy steaming by the wind S.E. by E at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 10 were Ship to the westward Middle part the wind and weather the same Latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail one Ship in sight saw Furbacks and Flumphbacks and Landfish So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 4-44 Lon 82-10
