Remarks on Board Thursday September 4th

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S S E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Westward at 6 P M shortened sail too Ships in sight Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A M made sail at 8 more Ship and steaming S S E by S S E saw Finbacks So Ends Lat by Ob 1-20 Lon 83

Remarks on Board Friday 5th

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes and good weather steaming S S E by S at 6 P M shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the S S E Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A M made sail to Ships in sight at 9 kept the Ship of S S E at 8 saw whales put of that could not strike came on Board at 10 saw whales put of struck one and killed him and took him along side So Ends No Ob Lon 82-20

Remarks on Board Saturday 6th

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S S E and pleasant weather employed Cutting at 2 P M finished and felled 1 way to the Eastward at 10 more Ship Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather at 2 A M more Ship And again at 8 and at 11 saw whales to windward So Ends three Ships in sight Lat by Ob 5-39 Lon 82-10

Remarks on Board Sunday 7th

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S S E and good weather at 2 P M saw whales put of and struck one and killed him and took him along side and cut him in and continued Drilling at 12 more Ship to the westward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 A M more Ship to the Eastward So Ends all hands employed Drilling three Ships in sight No Ob Lon 82-30

Remarks on Board Monday 8th

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S S E and foggy steaming by the wind to the Eastward ~~three~~ employed Drilling three Ships in sight at 8 P M finished Drilling Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes and Cloudy at 10 P M more Ship and at 2 A M more back Again saw Finbacks and Thumpbacks So Ends Lat by Ob 5-36 Lon 81-45

Remarks on Board Tuesday September 6th 1891

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S S E steaming by the wind to the Westward the weather Cloudy one Ship in sight Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A M more Ship at 10 A M set the Main Sail and Main Top Gallantail So Ends Lat by Ob 5-28 Lon 82-15

Remarks on Board Wednesday 7th

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S S E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P M took in the Main and Main Top Gallantail at 10 more Ship and Again at 2 Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 A M set the Main sail and Main Top Gallantail saw Thumpbacks So Ends Lat by Ob 5-16 Lon 81-40

Remarks on Board Thursday 8th

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and thick weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P M took in the Main Sail and Main Top Gallantail at 8 more Ship and took in the Jib and Spanker and Double Reefed the fore Top Sail Middle and Latter parts the same at 2 A M set the Jib and Spanker one Ship in sight saw Blackfish So Ends with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 3-7 Lon 82-25

Remarks on Board Friday 9th

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S S E and Cloudy at 6 set the Main sail and let one Reef out of the Main Top sail and one out of the fore one at 6 P M shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A M more Ship to the Eastward and set the Jib and Spanker and Main sail So Ends Lat by Ob 5-10 Lon 83-10

Remarks on Board Saturday 10th

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S S E and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 6 A M made sail at 7 saw whales put of and struck 1 number same dimensions and some parted Lines and after all got but one and took him along side So Ends Lat by Ob 5-15 Lon 82-30
