

Remarks on Board Sunday September 11-1831

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at S S E and good weather
but in the whale and stood to the Eastward by the wind at 6 P.M.
shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather
the same at 10 P.M. tacked to the S.W. at 6 A.M. made sail and began
to Brail one Ship in sight So Ends Lat by Ob 5-1 Lon 82-10

Remarks on Board Monday 12

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at South were Ship
to the Eastward at 6 P.M. finished Brailing and spoke the Ship
Logan at 6 took in the Top Gellantails and fly jib Middle
And Latter parts light breezes with fog at 2 A.M. were Ship
to the Westward at 8 A.M. made sail at 9 were Ship So Ends
with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 5-7 Lon 82-30

Remarks on Board Tuesday 13

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at South and good
weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. were Ship
whale turn his flukes but never saw him after words
at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and
weather the same were Ship at 10 and at 2 and at 8 began to
store down at 9 were Ship So Ends all hands employed stowing
Down Lat by Ob 3-6 Lon 82-00

Remarks on Board Wednesday 14

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at S S E and good
weather steaming by the wind S.W. employed stowing down
at 1 P.M. saw whales Leaved and got too took them along
side and continued stowing down Middle and Latter parts
the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. finished stowing down
at 9 saw whales put of and got one at 10 commenced Cutting
So Ends all hands employed Cutting Lat by Ob 2-26 Lon 82-2.5

Remarks on Board Thursday 15

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at South
And good weather at 1 P.M. finished Cutting and braced full
leading to the Eastward at 6 were Ship and began to Brail
Middle part foggy Latter part fresh breezes at 1 A.M. were
Ship to the Eastward So Ends all hands employed Brailing
Lat by Ob 2-13 Lon 82

Remarks on Board Friday September 16-1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and rough weather
steaming by the wind to the Eastward under short sail employed
Brailing at 6 P.M. were Ship Middle and Latter parts more moderate
at 10 A.M. made same sail at 11 finished Brailing So Ends
Lat by Ob 2-10 Lon 82-10

Remarks on Board Saturday 17

First part of this 24 hours light breezes from S S E to South at 6 P.M.
were Ship to the Eastward Middle and Latter the wind the same
And the weather good at 6 A.M. broke out and began stowing down
our Oil saw Compuis So Ends all hands employed stowing down
Lat by Ob 2-10 Lon 82-20

Remarks on Board Sunday 18

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at S S W and good weather
steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. finished stowing down
at 10 tacked Ship Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather
the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship at 6 made all sail saw Pinkbacks
And Compuis So Ends Lat by Ob 2-10 Lon 82

Remarks on Board Monday 19

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at South and
good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 8 P.M.
were Ship Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather
the same at 9 A.M. saw whales put of and got four So Ends
the whales not Morgue Lat by Ob 2-10 Lon 82-10

Remarks on Board Tuesday 20

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S S E and rough
At 1 P.M. got our whales along side and shortened sail and began
to cut saw whales along distance of at 4 quieted Cutting for the night
Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M.
began to cut again at 10 A.M. finished Cutting and filled away and
stood to the Eastward by the wind saw Breachis to windward
So Ends all hands employed in taking care of our 6 Blubber
And Cutting up the heads and fitting the Boats and other things
Lat by Ob 2-29 Lon 82-20
