First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes and good weather steaming by the wind & S.E. employed Bailing saw Breaches to windward at 8 P.M. wore Ship Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship and made sail So Ends employed Bailing

Remarks on Board Thursday<sup>th</sup> 22

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.S.W. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward employed Bailing Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 1 P.M. finished Bailing at 2 wore Ship at 4 made sail saw Flumpbacks So Ends with Ships Duty

Remarks on Board Friday<sup>th</sup> 23

First part of this 24 hours lte breezes from S.S.E. to S.S.W. at 4 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts the wind the same and weather good at 6 A.M. began to bake out the fore Hold and Cooper our Bread which we found some very Bad for the want of flaging when put up at Home. and shift our fresh water to preserve the Cask So Ends saw Blackfish and Finbacks

Remarks on Board Saturday<sup>th</sup> 24

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.S.E. to S.S.W. And good weather all hands employed baking out and Coopering our Bread and shifting our water at 4 P.M. wore Ship to the Westward Middle and Latter parts the same found some of the Bread in the Drum Cask very full of worms And very rotten for the want of flaging when put up at Home So Ends

Remarks on Board Sunday<sup>th</sup> 25

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from South to S.S.W. at 4 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward finished stowing down our Bread and Water Middle and Latter parts the wind the same steaming by the wind to the Eastward the weather tolerable good So Ends

Remarks on Board Monday September<sup>th</sup> 26 1831

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes and good weather steaming by the wind & S.E. one Ship insight at half past five saw whales hoised and got one took him along side shortened sail and lay by for the night Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. began to Cut out & finished and filled 8 way to the Eastward at 10 began to Bail parted the shings of the fore Yard and fitted some new ones So Ends employed Bailing

Remarks on Board Tuesday<sup>th</sup> 27

First part of this 24 hours lte breezes at South and good weather at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the Westward Middle and Latter parts the same at 2 A.M. finished Bailing at 6 washed of and made all sail So Ends with Ships Duty No Ob Lon 82-30

Remarks on Board Wednesday<sup>th</sup> 28

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at South and good weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 10 wore Ship to the Eastward Middle part the same Latter part fresh breezes from S.S.E. to South steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 10 A.M. turned the Reef out of the Main Top-sail and set the Main Top Yellow sail So Ends saw two Flumpbacks

Remarks on Board Thursday<sup>th</sup> 29

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. took in the Main Top Yellow-sail and one Reef in the Main Top-sail at 10 tacked Ship Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 6 made sail So Ends Nothing worth Remarks

Remarks on Board Friday<sup>th</sup> 30

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and Cloudy at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 8 tacked Ship to the Westward Middle part the same Latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail saw Finbacks and Papuas So Ends all well in Board
