First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze at South and good weather tacked Ship to the Eastward at 6 shortened sail Middle Latter parts the same at 8 AM made sail So Ends employed mending Sails
Lat by Ob 3-30 Lon 81-45

Remarks on Board Sundayth 2

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S by W and good weather at 6 PM shortened sail at 8 tacked Ship to the Westward Middle part fresh breezes and equally Latter part more moderate at 8 made sail at 10 AM saw 2 Ship to windward Bearing So Ends saw Finbacks Flumpbacks and Casperus
Lat by Ob 3-58 Lon 82-25

Remarks on Board Mondayth 3

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S S E and good weather at 6 PM shortened sail and tacked Ship to the Eastward Middle part strong breezes and equally Latter part much the same at 6 AM set the jib and Spanker at 9 set the Main sail So Ends with Ships Duty saw Blackfish
Lat by Ob 4-3 Lon 82-10

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 4

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 10 PM wore Ship And again at 2 AM Middle and Latter parts moderate breezes and Cloudy at 10 AM saw 2 Ship to windward standing to the Westward So Ends
No Ob - - Lon 81-45

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 5

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from South to S S W steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 5 PM saw the Land at 6 shortened sail and tacked Ship Middle And Latter parts the same at 2 AM saw 2 Ship standing to the Eastward. wore Ship and stood that way at 10 spoke the Ship American So Ends the weather Cloudy

Remarks on Board Thursday October 6-1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and Cloudy at 1 PM spoke the Ship Bruce Capt Chase with 1250 Oil stood to the Westward by the wind saw three other Ships Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 AM tacked Ship to Ships in sight So Ends Lat by Ob 4-23 Lon 82-20

Remarks on Board Fridayth 6

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S S E and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 PM shortened sail at 10 tacked of at 2 AM tacked in Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 AM spoke the Brage Mercury Capt Price five days from Tombez and got some few Bottles And Lumpkin's So Ends Lat by Ob 4-38 Lon 81-45

Remarks on Board Saturdayth 7

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward in Company with Capt Price at 8 PM tacked Ship Middle and Latter parts more moderate at 6 AM made sail and tacked Ship to the Eastward So Ends employed cleaning the Ship too Ships in sight the Land at Noon 15 Leagues distant Bayta Head Bearing S by E
Lat by Ob 4-55 Lon 81-25

Remarks on Board Sundayth 8

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South and Cloudy stood into the mouth of Bayta Harbour until the Shipping were in sight and then tacked of and shortened sail Middle part like breezes and thick weather lay of and on next morning and then made sail and stood in Bent the cables And got the Ship in order to go into Bant at Noon came to Anchor in nine fathoms water in Bayta Harbour

Remarks on Board Mondayth 10

All this 24 hours fresh ^{moderate} and Cloudy weather was watch on Show and the Remainder employed in Ships Duty Painting And other necessary jobs. here we feed and take on Board Laerderson Mantor. who presents himself as well and able to do his duty on Board as Required So Ends all well
