First part of this 24 hours fresh Trades and Cloudy weather
Middle part the same Latter part more moderate one half
the Crews on Shore and the remainder employed in Ships Duty
So Ends a number of small Craft passing in and out the Harbour

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 12

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes and Cloudy weather
Middle and Latter parts more moderate one half the Crews
on Shore and the remainder employed in Ships Duty
at 10 AM arrived the Ship

Remarks on Board Thursdayth 13

First part of this 24 hours fresh Trades and Cloudy weather
Middle and Latter parts more moderate A number of small
sail in sight. one watch on Shore and the rest employed
in Ships Duty

Remarks on Board Fridayth 14

First part of this 24 hours fresh Trades and Cloudy weather
Middle and Latter parts more moderate one watch on Shore
And the remainder employed in Ships Duty such as getting
Potatoes and Onions and Bumpkins on Board

Remarks on Board Saturdayth 15

First part of this 24 hours fresh Trades and Cloudy weather
fore Ships left the Harbour some for Torrey and others
for Sea Middle and more moderate one watch on Shore and
the remainder employed in Ships Duty

Remarks on Board Sundayth 16

First part of this 24 hours fresh Trades and Cloudy weather
All Hands employed stowing away Potatoes Onions and
Bumpkins and setting up the Drigins and other necessary
jobs. Middle and Latter parts the wind very light
And weather pleasant at 8 AM set the Cables and
received A visit from the Custom House Officer at 10
Gave short and got ready for Sea at Noon received
A visit from the Capt of the Port So Ends all ready
for Sea

Remarks on Board Monday Octth 17 - 1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh Trades and Cloudy at 2 PM
took our Anchor and made sail steaming out by the wind
All hands employed stowing the Cables and Anchors at 6 PM
Bight Head Raining S.E. & E Distance five leagues at 9 saw
A Brig standing in Middle and Latter parts moderate
breeze from S.E. to South stand off by the wind saw one Schoon
So Ends all hands employed putting our Boards and other
necessary jobs

Lat by Ob 52-8 Lon 82-15

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 18

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at South and good
weather steaming by the wind to the Westward at 6 PM
shortened sail Middle and Latter parts moderate
breezes from South to S.E. steaming by the wind to the West
at 6 AM made sail saw Pinbacks So Ends with Ships Duty

Lat by Ob 6-00 Lon 80-50

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 19

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy
weather steaming by the wind to the Westward at 6 PM shortened
sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same
At 8 AM made sail saw Pinbacks Flumpbacks and Blackfish
So Ends with Ships Duty

No Ob = Lon 83-20

Remarks on Board Thursdayth 20

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy
weather steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 6 PM shortened sail
Middle and Latter parts moderate breezes from S.E. to E.S.E.
steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 AM made sail
saw Blackfish and Pinbacks So Ends Lat by Ob 8-22 Lon 86-30

Remarks on Board Fridayth 21

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at E.S.E. and
good weather steaming by the wind to the Southward Middle
and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 9 AM
tacked Ship to the S.E. at 8 saw whales at 10 hauled
And struck A long whale So Ends No Ob = Lon 87-30
