

Remarks on Board Saturday Oct^r 22-1801

First part of this 24 hours lile breezes at ESE and good weather got our whale dead and fastened to another and killed him and took them both along side and began to cut Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same but in one whale and got the other ones Head of So Ends at Noon whales in sight No Ob - - Lon 87-50

Remarks on Board Sunday^r 23

First part of this 24 hours lile breezes at ESE and good weather at 2 PM leaved our Boats and struck along whale and killed him and took him along side got one Boat lately stove finished cutting the Bridges of the others And began to boil Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same all hands employed taking in the Gunks and Brailing the Carcass So Ends whales in sight And one Brague Lat by Ob 2-50 Lon 88-20

Remarks on Board Monday^r 24

First part of this 24 hours lile breezes at ESE and good weather finished Brailing the Carcass and taking in the Gunks and began to cut the other whale Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same finished cutting the whale except the Head at 2 AM spoke the Ship John Howland of New Bedford with 1400 So Ends employed Brailing and cutting Lat by Ob 2-50 Lon 89-30

Remarks on Board Tuesday^r 25

All this 24 hours lile breezes at ESE and good weather at 2 PM finished cutting and braced feet the head Yards heading to the Eastward by the wind all hands employed Brailing one Ship in sight Lat by Ob 2-22 Lon 90-00

Remarks on Board Wednesday^r 26

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at ESE with lile squalls of Rain at 5 PM wore Ship to the Southward all hands employed Brailing Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 5 AM finished Brailing at 8 AM began to break out the Hold in order for stowing down one Brague in sight So Ends Lat by Ob 2-16 Lon 90-30

Remarks on Board Thursday Oct^r 27-1801

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at ESE and good weather wore Ship and commenced stowing down at 6 PM wore back to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind the same with lile squalls of Rain all hands employed stowing down So Ends one Brague in sight Lat by Ob 10-2 Lon 91-00

Remarks on Board Friday^r 28

First part of this 24 hours lile breezes at ESE and cloudy weather standing to the Southward by the wind under short sail employed stowing down Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same finished stowing down and wore Ship at 10 AM spoke the Courier Capt Barnard Bound Home wore Ship and stood to the Southward in Company So Ends the Brague in sight Lat by Ob 10-35 Lon 90-30

Remarks on Board Saturday^r 29

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at ESE and cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Southward the Courier in Company at 5 PM spoke the Brague Nushua Capt Whittan Bound Home at 8 PM shortened sail and wore Ship to the So Ends Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 AM made sail So Ends with Ship Duty Lat by Ob 10-25 Lon 89-20

Remarks on Board Sunday^r 30

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at ESE and cloudy weather steaming by the wind So at 6 PM shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 AM made sail at 10 wore the John Howland cutting a large whale So Ends with a sharp lookout one Finback in sight Lat by Ob 2-15 Lon 88-30

Remarks on Board Monday^r 31

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at ESE by E and cloudy weather at 1 PM tacked Ship to the Southward at 5 spoke the John Howland and wore Ship to the So Ends Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 AM tacked Ship So Ends employed mending a Boat And other necessary John Lat by Ob 2-35 Lon 88-15
