

Remarks on Board Tuesday Novth 1-1831

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes and good weather at 1 P.M. saw a large whale going to windward leaved and chased him but could not come up with him saw the John Howland cutting at 10 P.M. tacked Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the same So Ends at Noon tacked Ship to the S.E. Lat by Ob 10-2 Lon 88-55

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 2

First part of this 24 hours light breezes from E. to S.E. And good weather steaming by the wind to the S.E. at 5 P.M. saw the John Howland manœuvring for whales and kept off for her but saw nothing at 6 P.M. she took a whale along side and we shortened sail in hopes to be right in the morning Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship to the Southward at 6 made sail saw Blackfish and one Finback Lat 10-00 Lon 88-25

Remarks on Board Thursdayth 3

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at S.E. and good weather at 1 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.E. at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 4 A.M. made sail at 7 were Ship and steamed W.B.W. at 10 saw the John Howland at Noon saw whales all hands employed shifting our fresh water on the account of rotten Cask So Ends in Chase Lat by Ob 9-21 Lon 88-30

Remarks on Board Fridayth 4

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather at 1 P.M. leaved our Boats and struck a large whale and killed him at 5 got him along side all hands employed getting ready for cutting Middle and Latter the wind and weather the same Cut of the Head and got in the Body the John Howland in sight saw Breachers So Ends Lat by Ob 9-12 Lon 88-45

Remarks on Board Saturday Novemberth 5-1831

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather finished cutting and filled 11 way and stood to the East by the wind employed Breiling Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 7 A.M. were Ship to the Southward So Ends the John Howland in sight Lat by Ob 9-8 Lon 88-30

Remarks on Board Sundayth 6

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Southward under short sail employed Breiling Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes and Cloudy at 12 belock were Ship to the S.E. at 7 A.M. finished Breiling and made sail So Ends Lat by Ob 9-14 Lon 88-00

Remarks on Board Mondayth 7

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather at 1 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. made sail So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 9-20 Lon 88-45

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 8

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather tacked Ship to the S.E. saw Blackfish at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. made sail one Ship in sight standing to the Southward So Ends Lat by Ob 9-8 Lon 88

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 9

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy were Ship to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship at 8 made sail saw Finbacks So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 9-36 Lon 87-40
