Remarks on Board Friday^r 2

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by wind to the Southward employed Beating Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same At 5 A.M. finished Beating at 8 commenced Breaking out in order for stowing down So Ends saw Blackfish Lat by Ob 10-43 Lon 89-05

Remarks on Board Saturday^r 3

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather standing by the wind to the Southward employed stowing down Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. wore Ship to the Eastward under short sail stowing down Thomas Francis of Duty with A. Lane Leg So Ends Lat by Ob 11-6 Lon 90-00

Remarks on Board Sunday^r 4

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind S.E. under short sail employed stowing down at 2 A.M. finished the bit and commenced on the Reef and Deck and Coopers and filled it up with Pickled and stowed it down So Ends saw Blackfish Ha Ob = Lon 89-20

Remarks on Board Monday^r 5

All this 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. to E.S.E. and rough weather employed stowing down Cleaning Ship and other necessary jobs at 2 A.M. wore Ship to the Southward at 4 A.M. made some sail saw Blackfish So Ends Ha Ob = Lon 89-10

Remarks on Board Tuesday Dec^r 6-1831

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and rough weather at 6 P.M. Double Reefed the fore and Main Top sails and took in the jib and Mizzen Top sail at 2 A.M. wore Ship to the Eastward at 10 set the jib and Mizzen Top sail So Ends with Ships Duty Ha Ob = Lon 89-30

Remarks on Board Wednesday^r 7

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. Double the main Top sail Middle and Latter parts more moderate At 10 A.M. turned the Reefs out of the Fore and Main Top sail And set the Main Top Gellant sail wore A. Farbank So Ends Thomas Francis no better and Mauter very feeble At 6 A.M. wore Ship Lat by Ob 10-52 Lon 89-15

Remarks on Board Thursday^r 8

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 4 A.M. made sail saw Blackfish unless the Fore Top sail and bent the old one So Ends employed in Ships Duty Lat by Ob 12-2 Lon 89-50

Remarks on Board Friday^r 9

All this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to E.S.E. and Cloudy At 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 2 A.M. made sail So Ends nothing in sight Thomas Francis no think something better Lat by Ob 11-10 Lon 89-10

Remarks on Board Saturday^r 10

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather at 2 P.M. saw Blackfish at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes and Cloudy at 2 A.M. set the jib and Main Top Gellant sail So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 10-15 Lon 89-40
