

Remarks on Board Sunday Janth 15 - 1832

All this 24 hours lute breezes from S by E to S by S at 10 A.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. and at 2 tacked to S by E at 6 saw the Island Lohan de Mer having 8 by 16 Distance 4 Leagues stood on until the Island bearing S.E. saw a Brig lying at an Anchor saw Flumpbacks at 10 tacked to the S.W. at Noon the Island Bearing East 3 Leagues Lat by Ob 6-56 Lon 80-53

Remarks on Board Mondayth 16

First part of this 24 hours lute breezes at S by E and good weather steaming by the wind S.W. at 2 P.M. saw a Ship to leeward and run of for her at 6 P.M. spoke the Ship Lasant Capt. Russell with 100 Middle part Calm Latter part the wind very lute at 8 A.M. wore Ship to the Eastward the Lasant in sight So Ends Lat by Ob 6-48 Lon 81-00

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 17

First part of this 24 hours lute breezes at S.E. and good weather at 6 P.M. wore Ship to the S.W. Middle part the same Latter part fresh breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Southward saw a Ship to windward and saw 6 Blackfish So Ends Lat by Ob 7-33 Lon 81-30

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 18

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and good weather at 1 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 6 took in the Top Gallant sails at 10 tacked Ship to the Southward Middle part the same Latter part the wind lute at 2 A.M. tacked to the S by E at 11 tacked to the S.W. by S So Ends with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 7-19 Lon 81-00

Remarks on Board Thursdayth 19

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind S.W. at 10 P.M. took in the Fore Top Gallant sail and Top jib and at 6 A.M. set them again saw 6 Blackfish Swordfish and Sunfish So Ends Lat by Ob 8-29 Lon 81-45

Remarks on Board Friday Janth 20 - 1832

All this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to S by E at 2 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 8 A.M. tacked back again to the Southward saw 6 Blackfish So Ends with 2 good Lookout from Mast head and other Duty Lat by Ob 8-28 Lon 81-50

Remarks on Board Saturdayth 21

All this 24 hours lute breezes from S by S to S by E at 2 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 10 tacked to the Southward all sail set to the Best advantage So Ends saw 6 Blackfish and other small Fish Lat by Ob 9-1 Lon 82-15

Remarks on Board Sundayth 22

All this 24 hours lute breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Southward under all sail nothing in sight weather Remarks Lat by Ob 10-12 Lon 82-37

Remarks on Board Mondayth 23

First part of this 24 hours lute breezes at S.E. and good weather at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward Middle part lute breezes at S by E at 10 P.M. tacked Ship to the Southward Latter part the same saw 6 Blackfish and Swordfish at Noon saw 3 sperm whales to windward So Ends Lat by Ob 10-53 Lon 82-50

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 24

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S by S and good weather at 1 P.M. the whales fore miles of one part of the weather Bore part of and got three Middle part lay by Latter part cut in the whales at Noon saw 3 whales to windward Bore part fell and got sail on the Ship So Ends steaming by the wind to the Eastward in Chace Lat by Ob 10-45 Lon 82-30

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 25

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S by S and rough weather stood to the Eastward until 2 P.M. tacked to the S.W. until 4 then to the S by E the whales in sight at 6 going to windward Middle part more moderate tacked date Latter part the wind very lute made all sail employed Boiling So Ends Lat by Ob 11-4 Lon 82-47
