Remarks on Board Wednesday Febth 8

First part of this 24 hours lile breezes from S.E. to S.W. and good weather at 6 P.M. finished Bailing and quietted stowing down for the present Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same all hands employed starting water and Iron Stoops and other things at 9 P.M. wave Ship to the S.W. So Ends with a good lookout

Remarks on Board Thursday Febth 16

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and lay by Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. Broke out and got ready for stowing down at 9 Braced full and steaming S.W. employed stowing down So Ends A number of the men complaining of poor Legs and lame Backs
