All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather at 4 P.M. Benjamin came on Board at 2 P.M. Joshua & Bissell came on Board but no sight of the other two. The Capt. still on Shore in pursuit of them at 4 A.M. sent two Boats after water and maidout to get a small raft the Surf running very big got one Boat stove and one Man hurt at 10 A.M. took three B. Buck on Board So Ends with Ships Duty

Remarks on Board Thursdayth 8

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather. Had some company from the shore but could not hear anything correct from our men Middle and Latter the wind and weather the same at 9 A.M. the Governor fetched Thomas Beach to the Beach and we took him on Board at 10 A.M. got under way and left the Harbor of Guaymas at 12 noon the Anchorage Baring 10 1/2 miles Distance So Ends

Remarks on Board Fridayth 9

First part of this 24 hours like breezes from South to S.E. steaming by the wind to the Westward stowed the Anchors and Cables and others necessary things Middle part the wind very lite Latter part strong breezes at S.E. steaming S.W. saw A. B. Bay standing to the Eastward So Ends with Ships Duty

Remarks on Board Saturdayth 10

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. And Cloudy steaming S.W. under Double Reef Tops Middle and Latter parts more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail the wind lite So Ends with a good lookout

Remarks on Board Sunday Marchth 11-1832

First part of this 24 hours like breezes from S.E. to S.W. and good weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail saw one Finback Middle part fresh breezes with squalls of Rain Lat 3 A.M. wore Ship to the Eastward Latter part more moderate at 7 A.M. made sail So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 11-57 Lon 80-25

Remarks on Board Mondayth 12

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather. steaming by the wind to the S.E. at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail saw Finbacks So Ends with Ships Duty

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 13

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and good weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail and tacked Ship to the S.W. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same At 6 A.M. made sail So Ends repairing sails

Lat by Ob 11-31 Lon 79-45

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 14

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to S.W. and good weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail and tacked Ship to the S.E. Middle and Latter parts strong breezes and Cloudy all hands employed repairing sails and other necessary jobs So Ends saw Blackfish and B. pupis

Lat by Ob 11-9 Lon 78-20

Remarks on Board Thursdayth 15

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather made sail. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and tacked Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter part fresh breezes and Cloudy at 2 A.M. took in the jib and Main sail at 7 saw Finbacks So Ends employed repairing sails strong Current to the S.W. Lat by Ob 11-40 Lon 79-50
