First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and cloudy steaming by the wind to the Southward employed repairing sails at 6 P.M. wore Ship Middle and Latter part the wind and weather more moderate turned the Reef out of the Main Top-sail and set the Main Top Gallant sail to Ende with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 11-22 Lon 77-20

Remarks on Board Saturday <sup>th</sup> 17

All this 24 hours strong breezes and cloudy at 6 P.M. took in the Main Top Gallant sail and tacked Ship to the S.W. the wind at S.E. wore Finbacks and Smeadfish to Ende Lat by Ob 11-58 Lon 80-00

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and cloudy steaming by the wind to the Southward Middle and Latter the same to Ende with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 13-13 Lon 80-45

Remarks on Board Monday <sup>th</sup> 19

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and very rough at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the E.S.E. Middle and Latter part more moderate at 10 A.M. made sail All hands employed repairing and muddling sticking the Main Top-sail to Ende Lat by Ob 00-00 Lon 79-20

Remarks on Board Tuesday <sup>th</sup> 20

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather at 6 P.M. wore Ship to the S.W. Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 9 A.M. tacked Ship to the E.S.E. to Ende all hands employed repairing sails Lat by Ob 12-50 Lon 79-20

Remarks on Board Wednesday <sup>th</sup> 21

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to S.W. at 2 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. wore Blackfish Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. wore Ship to the E.S.E. at 4 A.M. tacked to the S.W. wore Finbacks to Ende with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 12-55 Lon 79-00

Remarks on Board Thursday March <sup>th</sup> 22-1832

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. tacked Ship to the E.S.E. wore Gyronfuris and Finbacks Middle part the same Latter part fresh breezes from S.E. to S.W. steaming by the wind to the Eastward to Ende with a good lookout and other Duty Lat by Ob 12-25 Lon 78-00

Remarks on Board Friday <sup>th</sup> 23

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at South and good weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. Middle part the same Latter part fresh breezes from S.E. to S.W. at 9 A.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward to Ende Lat by Ob 12-16 Lon 77-50

Remarks on Board Saturday <sup>th</sup> 24

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. at 8 the wind began to breeze took in the Fore Top Gallant sail and fly jib Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes and cloudy took in the Main and Mizzen Top Gallant sails and Double Breasted the Top-sails and at 9 A.M. turned them Breasts out again to Ende Lat by Ob 13-18 Lon 77-45

Remarks on Board Sunday <sup>th</sup> 25

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at South and good weather tacked Ship to the Eastward and made all sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same At 10 A.M. tacked Ship and at 2 tacked again to the Eastward All sail set to the best advantage and a good Lookout at Mouthhead to Ende Lat by Ob 10-00 Lon 77-20

Remarks on Board Monday <sup>th</sup> 26

All this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to South and good weather at 8 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. at 2 A.M. tacked to the E.S.E. at 9 A.M. tacked to the S.W. all sail set to the best advantage to Ende with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 11-9 Lon 77-00

Remarks on Board Tuesday <sup>th</sup> 27

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather at 3 P.M. spoke the Ship Robert Edwards of Linn Bedford Capt Howland with 150 at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the E.S.E. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. tacked to the S.W. at 8 wore Blackfish to Ende Lat by Ob 12-16 Lon 77-15
