

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 28-1892

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and good weather at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the S E at 10 took in the Top Gallantails and Reefed the Top sails Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at Noon the Land in sight So Ends saw Blackfish

Lat by Ob 14-59 Lon 76-45

Remarks on Board Thursday 29

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E by S and good weather At 6 P.M. tacked Ship to S W by S and Middle and Latter parts the same at 6 A.M. wore Ship to the S by S at 10 A.M. set the Top Gallantails at Noon the Land 15 Leagues Distant So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 15-16 Lon 75-59

Remarks on Board Friday 30

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and good weather at 6 P.M. tacked Ship and shortened Sail Middle part like breezes and pleasant weather at 2 P.M. tacked Ship to the S E at 6 made sail Latter part Strong breezes and Cloudy at 10 took in the Fore and Mizzen Top Gallantails at 11 tacked Ship to the S W the Land 10 miles Distant saw Plumbacks So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 15-18 Lon 75-25

Remarks on Board Saturday 31

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and good weather at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the S W and shortened sail Middle part the same Latter part more moderate At 6 A.M. wore Ship and made sail at 10 kept of North the Land 2 Leagues Distant So Ends all well. A plenty of Plumbacks in sight Lat by Ob 15-20 Lon 75-22

Remarks on Board Sunday Apr 1

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E and good weather steaming S W at 6 P.M. shortened sail and stood to the S W at 11 saw A Brig standing to the W S W Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail and steaming S W saw A number of Scurvyfish So Ends Lat by Ob 15-58 Lon 75-50

Remarks on Board Monday April 2-1892

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E by E and good weather steaming to the S W until 6 P.M. then wore Ship and steaming S E by S took in the fore and Mizzen Top Gallantails and fly jib and at 10 A.M. set them again and kept the Ship of North at 11 S E W and at Noon W by S the Land 3 Leagues Distant So Ends Lat by Ob 15-16 Lon 75-20

Remarks on Board Tuesday 3

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E and good weather. steaming W by S at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same At 6 A.M. made sail at 10 steaming S W saw Blackfish and Finbacks So Ends Lat by Ob 14-50 Lon 76-55

Remarks on Board Wednesday 4

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E and good weather. steaming W S W at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the same at 6 A.M. made sail saw one Finback and A number of Scurvyfish So Ends Lat by Ob 14-8 Lon 78-15

Remarks on Board Thursday 5

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E and good weather. steaming S W by W at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail saw Finbacks and Scurvyfish So Ends with A good Lookout and everything in good order for whaling Lat by Ob 15-3 Lon 79-00

Remarks on Board Friday 6

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S E and good weather. steaming S E by W at 6 P.M. shortened sail and luffed by the wind to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts the same At 9 A.M. made sail and saw A Breach of the Ice beam and kept of it at 10 luffed too again to the Eastward saw nothing but Scurvyfish So Ends all well Lat by Ob 12-5 Lon 78-50
