

Remarks on Board Saturday <sup>April 7-1832</sup> ~~March~~

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 10 tacked Ship and again at 2 A.M. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather to the same at 10 A.M. saw whales of the Lee and kept of for the at Noon leaved the Boats to Ende in Chase Lat by Ob 11-28 Lon 78-40

Remarks on Board Sunday <sup>8</sup>

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather at 2 P.M. struck too large whales and lost one of them And one Line and too Irons at 5 P.M. got the whale to the Ship shortened sail and got ready for cutting Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes and rough at 5 A.M. commenced cutting at 8 saw three whales bound to windward very quick at 9 saw A Brig standing to the S.W. So Ende employed cutting Lat by Ob 11-15 Lon 78-20

Remarks on Board Monday <sup>9</sup>

First part of this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. and good weather but very rough at 5 P.M. finished cutting And made sail at 9 Receped the Fore and Main Top sail And took in the jib. and commenced B. Railing and wore Ship to the S.W. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same saw two whales to windward So Ende At 10 A.M. tacked Ship to the S.E. Lat by Ob 11-30 Lon 78-25

Remarks on Board Tuesday <sup>10</sup>

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and cloudy weather At 10 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. employed B. Railing At 9 A.M. wore Ship to the S.E. and made sail at 10 A.M. finished B. Railing So Ende Lat by Ob 11-28 Lon 78-25

Remarks on Board Wednesday <sup>11</sup>

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind S.E. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and tacked Ship to the S.W. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. wore Ship to the S.E. and at 9 A.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. and commenced Stowing Down saw Plumbecks So Ende Lat by Ob 11-24 Lon 78-30

Remarks on Board Thursday <sup>April 12-1832</sup>

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. finished stowing down We took in the jib and Fore and Main Spencers and wore Ship to the S.E. Middle part wore moderate Latter part fresh breezes and rough weather at 6 A.M. set the jib and Spencers So Ende employed repairing sails Lat by Ob 11-20 Lon 78-10

Remarks on Board Friday <sup>13</sup>

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. tacked Ship to the S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail and steaming West at 8 saw A Ship standing to the S.E. So Ende with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 11-59 Lon 79-15

Remarks on Board Saturday <sup>14</sup>

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and cloudy with little squalls of Rain. steaming S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the S.W. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 9 A.M. made sail And wore Ship to the S.E. So Ende Lat by Ob 11-28 Lon 80-00

Remarks on Board Sunday <sup>15</sup>

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and rough weather at 2 P.M. saw whales bound the Boats and chased them until sundown but could not strike came on Board and shortened sail and stood to the S.E. until 2 A.M. then wore Ship to the S.W. at 6 A.M. made sail at 10 wore Ship and steering S.E. at Noon whales in sight So Ende Lat by Ob 11-41 Lon 80-10

Remarks on Board Monday <sup>16</sup>

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes and rough weather at 12 past twelve leaved the Boats and chased the whales until sunset but could not strike came on Board And shortened sail and stood to the S.E. by the wind Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 9 A.M. saw whales made sail and at 10 leaved the Boats So Ende in Chase So Ob = = Lon 80-25
