First part of this 24 hours lile breezes and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. the Crew came on Board all well. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same all Hands employed in Ships Duty

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 22

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather at 3 P.M. took the Anchor and made sail and put to sea at 6 P.M. got the Anchor stowed and Cable coiled away. Light Head bearing S.E. distant 10 miles Middle and Latter parts the wind from S.E. to S.W. and good weather saw 2 Blue steaming by the wind to the Westward saw 2 Blackfish and two Brigs standing to the Eastward to Bonds employed in Ships Duty

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy saw 2 Finbacks and 2 Blackfish at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter part fresh breezes with lile squalls of Rain at 10 A.M. Reefed the Main Topmaste to Bonds steaming by the wind to the S.W. Lat by Ob 9-1 Lon 85-45
