First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy at 1 P.M. shortened sail and luffed by the wind to the S.W. Middle and Latter parts more moderate the wind from S.E. to E.S.E. steaming by the wind to the Southward at 4 A.M. made sail So Ends Lat by Ob 4-13 Lon 102

Remarks on Board Thursday th 21

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather. steaming by the wind to the Southward at 1 P.M. took in the Main Top Gaffentail Middle part equally Latter part more Moderate at 4 A.M. made sail too Ships in sight at 8 spoke the Ship Lima Capt Winslow with 200 and the Arab Capt Brunker with 250 So Ends Lat by Ob 6-9 Lon 105-10

Remarks on Board Friday th 22

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the S.E. the Lima and Arab in company at 1 P.M. saw whales partly and got one to each Ship Middle and Latter parts more moderate employed Cutting at 11 A.M. finished Cutting and braced full So Ends Lat by Ob 5-55 Lon 105-15

Remarks on Board Saturday th 23

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and equally steaming by the wind to the Eastward employed Boiling these Ships in sight and all of them Boiling So Ends with a good lookout So Ob = Lon 105-00

Remarks on Board Sunday th 24

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes and good weather Steaming by the wind to the Eastward too Ships in sight at 1 P.M. saw whales Loaved and got one and cut in the body and lay by the Head Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes and Cloudy at 5 A.M. took in the Head at 6 whales in sight at 9 put of and got one So Ends employed Cutting So Ob = Lon 105-15

Remarks on Board Monday June th 25-1832

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather at 1 P.M. finished Cutting and Commenced Boiling Middle part the same Latter part fresh breezes and rough at 5 A.M. wore Ship to the Southward saw Finbacks and one Ship So Ends employed Boiling Lat by Ob 5-9 Lon 105-45

Remarks on Board Tuesday th 26

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the S.E. employed Boiling at 1 P.M. wore Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 4 A.M. wore Ship So Ends finished Boiling strong Current setting to the S.W. Lat by Ob 5-7 Lon 106-00

Remarks on Board Wednesday th 27

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the South Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 4 A.M. wore Ship took in the jib and Mizen Top sail and Commenced stowing down So Ends Lat by Ob 6-12 Lon 106-20

Remarks on Board Thursday th 28

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Rough weather. steaming by the wind to the S.E. employed stowing down Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 4 A.M. finished stowing down So Ends Lat by Ob 5-26 Lon 106-00

Remarks on Board Friday th 29

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and very Rough too Ships in sight at 5 P.M. saw whales to windward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship to the Southward at 4 A.M. saw whales to windward and going to windward quick too Ships in sight So Ends Lat by Ob 5-12 Lon 105-55

Remarks on Board Saturday th 30

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Rough weather steaming by the wind to the S.E. at 1 P.M. spoke the Ship Omega Capt Chase with 238 at 4 spoke the Ship Bracco Capt Chase with 235 wore Ship to the South Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 4 A.M. tacked to the S.E. So Ends Lat by Ob 5-35 Lon 106-20
