First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and rough weather. steaming by the wind to the S.E. two Ships in sight at 2 P.M. saw whales to windward. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 4 N.M. tacked Ship. unbent the jib and bent the other to Ends

Remarks on Board Monday th 2

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and rough weather steaming by the wind to the Southward one Ship in sight at 10 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.E. Middle and Latter parts more moderate made sail two Ships in sight to Ends employed repairing the Main Top Gallantail

Lat by Ob. 5-12 Lon 106

Remarks on Board Tuesday th 3

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and rough weather. steaming S.E. at 5 P.M. finished repairing the Main Top Gallantail Middle and Latter parts more moderate at 6 N.M. tacked Ship the wind at S.E. bent the Main Top Gallantail and set him and the Fly jib to Ends with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob. 5-5.5 Lon 106

Remarks on Board Wednesday th 4

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and rough weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle part more moderate tacked to the S.E. Latter part very fluky at 6 N.M. tacked to the S.W. and made sail at 10 N.M. shortened sail two Ships in sight to Ends

Remarks on Board Thursday th 5

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and tacked Ship to the S.E. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 N.M. tacked to the S.W. at 8 tacked to the S.E. saw Finbacks made sail two Ships in sight to Ends Lat by Ob. 5-22 Lon 106-15

Remarks on Board Friday July th 6 - 1892

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 1 P.M. spoke the Ship Lima Capt. Winslow. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 N.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. to Ends with Ship's Duty three Ships in sight

Lat by Ob. 5-28 Lon 106-20

Remarks on Board Saturday th 7

First part of this 24 hours like breezes at S.E. and good weather. steaming by the wind to the Southward one Ship in sight at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same to Ends

Remarks on Board Sunday th 8

First part of this 24 hours like breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 10 P.M. tacked Ship at 11 took in the Top Gallantails and Fly jib. Middle part equally Latter part moderate breezes at S.E. steaming by the wind to the Southward under all sail three Ships in sight. saw Finbacks to Ends Lat by Ob. 5-5.5 Lon 106-15

Remarks on Board Monday th 9

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.E. Middle part the same Latter part equally and the wind from the S.E. at 7 N.M. tacked Ship to the Southward at 10 tacked Ship to the S.E. at 11 took in the Main Top Gallantail and Reefed the Main Top sail to Ends two Ships in sight Lat by Ob. 6-00 Lon 106

Remarks on Board Tuesday th 10

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and cloudy. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. unbent the Main Sail and bent another Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same two Ships in sight to Ends with Ship's Duty
