All this 24 hours fresh breezes from South to S.W. and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward under all sail saw Blackfish and Cowfish So Ends with Ships Duty the Oregon in sight Lat by Ob 00-22 Lon 85-40

Remarks on Board Sunday 5

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.W. and Cloudy weather steaming S.E. at 3 P.M. took in the Fore Top Gallantails And Fly jib at 4 A.M. took in the Main and Mizzen Top Gallantails at 8 A.M. set the Fly jib and Main Top Gallantails So Ends

Remarks on Board Monday 6

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to S.W. and good weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward with all sail set to the best advantage Middle and Latter parts the same So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 1-6 Lon 83-00

Remarks on Board Tuesday 7

All this 24 hours lile breezes from S.E. to South and good weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward. the Oregon in sight at 8 A.M. saw whales leaved and got one So Ends

Remarks on Board Wednesday 8

First part of this 24 hours lile breezes at South with fog at 2 P.M. finished Cutting and filled away steaming S.E. at 5 P.M. buffed by the wind to the Eastward and commenced Brailing Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 P.M. tacked Ship and again at 2 A.M. at 2 finish Brailing at 8 made sail and steaming by the wind to the Eastward So Ends the Oregon in sight Lat by Ob 2-22 Lon 81-48

Remarks on Board Thursday August 9 1832

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy with fog. steaming East at 6 P.M. shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the Eastward at 8 noon Ship and left the head gear Aback Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 11 A.M. braced full and made sail steaming by the wind to the Eastward saw Thompsons and Blackfish So Ends the Land in sight

Lat by Ob 2-21 Lon 81-5

Remarks on Board Friday 10

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the Westward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 A.M. made sail and steaming S.W. at 10 P.M. by W. at 10 A.M. I do la Plata having South by East Dis 20 saw Thompsons So Ends Lat by Ob 1-32 Lon 81-00

Remarks on Board Saturday 11

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at South and foggy weather at 6 P.M. I do la Plata having East Dis 10 shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the Westward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship at 6 made sail the Island in sight at noon the Island having S.E. So Ends Lat by Ob 1-05 Lon 81-5

Remarks on Board Sunday 12

First part of this 24 hours lile breezes at South and foggy weather at 3 P.M. came to Anchor in Salango in 15 fathoms water Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same So Ends with Ships Duty Gardner Tompkins unwell

Remarks on Board Monday 13

All this 24 hours lile breezes at S.E. and Bracing weather at 2 P.M. the crew went on Shore on Liberty and at 6 returned on Board. at 8 A.M. sent two Boats with the Cash for Water. and at 10 A.M. they came on Board and got their dinner And returned after the water So Ends Gardner Tompkins no better
