First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.S.E. and Cloudy weather at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the Westward and tookin the Fore Top Gallantail and fly jib Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather much the same at 8 A.M. set the fly jib and fore Top Gallantail So Ends saw Finbacks

Remarks on Board Wednesday #29

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.S.E. and Cloudy weather at 1 P.M. spoke the Branger Memura Ship Oregon and Ship Foster. At wore Ship to the Westward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same saw Flumplocks and Blackfish So Ends three Ships in sight

Remarks on Board Thursday August #30-1832

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.S.E. and Cloudy weather at 2 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward three Ships in sight at 6 P.M. took in the Fore and Mizzen Top Gallantails and fly jib. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. made sail. saw Blackfish at 10 saw A Ship to windward So Ends with Ships Lat by Ob 6-44 Lon 82-10

Remarks on Board Friday #31

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.S.E. and Cloudy weather at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the Westward Middle and Latter parts more moderate at 6 A.M. three Ships in sight at 9 A.M. saw Blackfish So Ends repairing the fore Top Gallantail

Lat by Ob 5-18 Lon 83-20

Remarks on Board Saturday #1, September

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.S.E. and Cloudy weather. *steaming by the wind to the Westward at 6 P.M. one Ship in sight. took in the Top Gallantails and fly jib Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail saw Carcas So Ends with Ships Duty

Lat by Ob 5-29 Lon 84-18

Remarks on Board Sunday #2

All this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.W. to S.E. and Cloudy weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail and at 6 A.M. made sail again steaming by the wind to the Westward saw A Carcas So Ends

Lat by Ob 6-10 Lon 85-30

Remarks on Board Monday #3

All this 24 hours fresh breezes from S.W. to S.E. and Cloudy weather. steaming by the wind to the Westward At 2 P.M. took in the Top Gallantails at 6 P.M. reefed the Top sails and took in the Main sail Middle and Latter parts more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail at 8 A.M. spoke the Ship Abgal Capt Clark with 500 all well So Ends saw Finbacks No Ob = Lon 86-50
