And Cloudy weather. steaming by the wind to the Westward
at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind
And weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail the Whigail in
sight So Ends
Lat by Ob 8-38 Lon 88-00

Remarks on Board Wednesday 3rd

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather
steaming by the wind to the S.W. the Whigail in sight
saw Finbacks and Blackfish So Ends employed repairing
sails
Lat by Ob 9-59 Lon 89-00

Remarks on Board Thursday 4th

All this 24 hours fresh breezes from East to S.E. and Cloudy
weather steaming by the wind to the Southward employed
repairing sails at 9 A.M. lost sight of the Whigail. saw
Finbacks. at Noon tacked Ship to the S.E. So Ends
Lat by Ob 10-28 Lon 89-50

Remarks on Board Friday 5th

All this 24 hours strong breezes from East to S.E. and
equally weather at 1 A.M. shortened sail at 6 A.M.
set the Spanker. steaming by the wind to the Southward
And Eastward So Ends with Ships Duty
Lat by Ob 10-29 Lon 88-50

Remarks on Board Saturday 6th

All this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. and equally weather
steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. took in the
Main sail and set the waist Boat on the upper Cairns
at 9 A.M. set the Main sail saw Finbacks So Ends
Lat by Ob 9-24 Lon 88-00

Remarks on Board Sunday 7th

First part of this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. and
equally weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward
at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind
And weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail saw Finbacks
So Ends
Lat by Ob 8-52 Lon 87-15

Remarks on Board Monday September 10th - 1832

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. to S.E. and equally
weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts more
moderate at 9 A.M. made sail and met the Flot saw one Ship
And a number of Finbacks So Ends with Ships Duty
Lat by Ob 7-50 Lon 86-25

Remarks on Board Tuesday 11th

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy
steaming by the wind to the Eastward saw Blackfish at 6 P.M.
shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather
the same at 6 A.M. made sail at 9 saw two sperm whales
going to the N.W. at 8 hoisted the Boats and wore Ship
at 10 got fast to one and got him Dead So Ends
Lat by Ob 7-5 Lon 85-40

Remarks on Board Wednesday 12th

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather
At 2 P.M. got the whale a long side at 6 commenced cutting
At 6 one had got of the head and got in the Body at 8 began
to Bail at 6 A.M. hooked on to the Junk and took it in
at 8 hooked on to the Case and set him on End for Bailing
at 10 finished and Bailed full and steaming by the wind to the
Eastward saw Finbacks So Ends employed Bailing
Lat by Ob 6-40 Lon 85-15

Remarks on Board Thursday 13th

All this 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. to S.E. by S. and Cloudy
weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward under short
sail employed Bailing saw Blackfish and Finbacks
at 10 A.M. finished Bailing So Ends with Ships Duty
Lat by Ob 6-19 Lon 84-20

Remarks on Board Friday 14th

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and
Cloudy weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward
at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 9 tacked Ship Middle and Latter
parts more moderate at 2 A.M. tacked Ship at 6 commenced
Stowing down at 8 one Ship in sight at 10 saw Finbacks
So Ends employed stowing down Lat by Ob 6-19 Lon 83-40
