

Remarks on Board Saturday Septemberth 15-1832

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather. Steaming by the wind to the Eastward Employed stowing down at 5 P.M. spoke the Whigail at 6 finished stowing down at 9 near Ship and then again at 2 A.M. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. made all sail two Ships in sight So Ends
Lat by Ob 6-16 Lon 82-50

Remarks on Board Sundayth 16

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather. Steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. spoke the Ship Independence Capt Whippley with 550. near Ship and stood to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward saw Humphreys and Blackfish So Ends one Ship in sight Lat by Ob 6-18 Lon 82-20

Remarks on Board Mondayth 17

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at S.E. and foggy weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail and near Ship to the S.W. Middle and Latter fresh breezes and Cloudy at 8 A.M. made sail one Ship in sight So Ends with Ship's Duty
Lat by Ob 6-32 Lon 82-45

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 18

All this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather Steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. took in the Top Gallant sails and Fift Jib at 7 A.M. made sail saw Finbacks So Ends Repairing the Jib
So Ob = Lon 84-10

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 19

All this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather Steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and at 7 A.M. made sail again saw Finbacks So Ends with Ship's Duty
Lat by Ob 8-22 Lon 85-45

Remarks on Board Thursday Septemberth 20-1832

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather Steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 7 A.M. made sail saw Finbacks So Ends
Lat by Ob 10-00 Lon 86-50

Remarks on Board Fridayth 21

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather Steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. saw whales leaved but could not strike at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter parts more moderate at 2 A.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 7 saw one whale at 9 leaved and chased untill Dawn and could not strike So Ends
Lat by Ob 10-27 Lon 87-5

Remarks on Board Saturdayth 22

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather at 6 P.M. the Boat came on Board Braced full and Steaming by the wind to the Eastward saw Blackfish at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. at 6 made sail saw Blackfish So Ends
Lat by Ob 10-29 Lon 86-50

Remarks on Board Sundayth 23

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather Steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. saw whales leaved and chased untill night but could not strike came on Board tacked Ship and shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship at 7 made sail saw Blackfish So Ends
Lat by Ob 11-6 Lon 87-5

Remarks on Board Mondayth 24

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the S.W. at 3 saw one whale leaved and chased but could not strike at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter parts more moderate at 8 A.M. made sail after wetting the Flood So Ends with Ship's Duty tacked Ship at 9 A.M. to the S.W. Lat by Ob 10-56 Lon 86-20
