

Remarks on Board Tuesday September 25-1832

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the S.W. at 2 P.M. saw whales bared and chased untill night but could not strike came on board and tacked ship to the S.E. and shortened sail Middle and Latter parts strong breezes and equally at 6 A.M. tacked ship to the S.W. to Ende employed repairing the Main Top sail Lat by Ob 10-12 Lon 86

Remarks on Board Wednesday 26

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. by Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts strong winds and equally at 2 A.M. wore ship at 8 saw one whale going to windward very quick just like all the rest that we have seen for this last seven days to Ende with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 11-12 Lon 86-30

Remarks on Board Thursday 27

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the S.E. at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle part the same Latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail saw Blackfish to Ende employed repairing sails Lat by Ob 10-15 Lon 85-40

Remarks on Board Friday 28

All this 24 hours strong breezes and equally weather steaming W.S.W. untill 6 P.M. then shortened sail and luffed by the wind to the S.W. at 6 A.M. made sail at 9 steaming S.W. saw Blackfish and Finbacks to Ende Lat by Ob 10-34 Lon 86-43

Remarks on Board Saturday 29

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and equally steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail and at 6 A.M. made sail saw Blackfish to Ende employed Repairing sails Lat by Ob 11-28 Lon 87-45

Remarks on Board Sunday September 30-1832

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail and wore ship to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail at 9 steaming S.E. untill noon to Ende Lat by Ob 11-6 Lon 87-20

Remarks on Board Monday October 1

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy steaming S.E. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and luffed by the wind to the S.E. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 9 A.M. after resting the Hold we made sail and steaming S.E. saw Finbacks to Ende Lat by Ob 9-57 Lon 86-45

Remarks on Board Tuesday 2

First part of this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. by Cloudy steaming S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and luffed by the wind to the Eastward Middle part the same Latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail at 8 steaming S.W. saw Blackfish and Finbacks to Ende Lat by Ob 8-49 Lon 86-55

Remarks on Board Wednesday 3

First part of this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. and equally steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same saw Blackfish and Finbacks to Ende Lat by Ob 9-54 Lon 87-35

Remarks on Board Thursday 4

First part of this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. and equally steaming by the wind to the Southward under short sail Middle part the same Latter part more moderate at 10 A.M. wore ship and made some sail to Ende with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 10-16 Lon 88-30

Remarks on Board Friday 5

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. by Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts the same at 9 A.M. made sail to Ende with a good lookout and every thing in order for whaling Lat by Ob 9-23 Lon 87-40
