First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and cloudy weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the same at 6 A.M. made sail saw Blackfish and Finbacks So Ends

Remarks on Board Sundayth 7

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Good weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 2 P.M. saw a whale of the weather beam too miles Distance stood on a suitable Distance and tacked Ship but could not see him again Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward So Ends

Remarks on Board Mondayth 8

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to E.S.E. and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter part the same at 6 A.M. saw whale's part of and struck two and saved one the other went off with a hook line and two lines So Ends employed Cutting

Lat by Ob 8-42 Lon 85-50

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 9

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. finished Cutting at 9 Commenced Boiling Breasted full the head yards and flaked the Main over Aback Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 9 A.M. saw one whale wore Ship and stood for him at 8 leaved and struck him and killed him at 9 took him along side So Ends employed Boiling

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 10

All this 24 hours light breezes at S.E. by E. and pleasant weather. lagging by with the Head Yards Aback employed Cutting and Boiling So Ends with a strong Current setting to the S.W.

Remarks on Board Thursday Octoberth 11-1832

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. by E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward under short sail employed Boiling at 10 A.M. saw A Ship of the line Bream standing to the Southward So Ends saw Blackfish Lat by Ob 7-37 Lon 85-45

Remarks on Board Fridayth 12

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and cloudy weather at 6 P.M. wore Ship to the Southward at 8 finished Boiling at 6 A.M. two Ships in sight at 8 made sail So Ends

Lat by Ob 8-7 Lon 86-10

Remarks on Board Saturdayth 13

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather at 2 P.M. tacked Ship to the E.S.E. at 2 spoke two Barques the Equator and Anabella at 6 wore Ship and shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. commenced stowing down So Ends

Lat by Ob 8-31 Lon 86-50

Remarks on Board Sundayth 14

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather. steaming by the wind to the S. Southward employed stowing down at 6 P.M. wore Ship. Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same. one Ship in sight. saw Finbacks and Blackfish So Ends employed stowing down.

Lat by Ob 8-28 Lon 86-15

Remarks on Board Mondayth 15

All this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to E.S.E. and cloudy weather at 3 P.M. finished stowing down and washed of the Decks at 6 A.M. made sail one Ship in sight So Ends steaming by the wind to the Eastward. So Ob = Lon 86-50

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 16

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 shortened sail and tacked Ship Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail. After setting the Hold. saw Finbacks and Blackfish So Ends with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 8-11 Lon 85-30
