First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the Eastward Middle part the same Latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. made sail at 8 steaming South S.E. ends Lat by Ob 9-58 Lon 87-25

Remarks on Board Wednesday 31

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming South at 6 P.M. shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail at 8 steaming S.W. S.E. ends saw Finbacks Lat by Ob 9-51 Lon 88-10

Remarks on Board Thursday 1 November

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather. steaming S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the S.E. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail at 9 steaming South S.E. ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 9-21 Lon 88-15

Remarks on Board Friday 2

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming South at 6 P.M. shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts the same at 6 A.M. made sail S.E. ends one Ship in sight Lat by Ob 8-27 Lon 87-20

Remarks on Board Saturday 3

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. saw whales leaved and got one Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same one Ship in sight S.E. ends employed Cutting Lat by Ob Lon 87-25

Remarks on Board Sunday 4

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather at 2 P.M. finished Cutting and hoisted full at 3 more Ship to the Southward at 8 Commenced Breeching at 9 A.M. set the Mizzen Top sail. Jib and Spanker one Ship in sight S.E. ends employed Breeching Lat by Ob 8-42 Lon 87-50

Remarks on Board Monday November 5 - 1832

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and equally weather at 3 P.M. spoke the Ship Oregon with 900 at 6 more Ship to the Eastward. saw Finbacks. at 8 Double Breefed the Top sails Fore and Main and took in the Mizzen S.E. ends employed Breeching Lat by Ob = Lon 87-15

Remarks on Board Tuesday 6

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather at 6 P.M. finished Breeching at 6 more Ship to the Southward one Ship in sight at 8 more Ship to the Eastward S.E. ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob = Lon 87-20

Remarks on Board Wednesday 7

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. took in the Jib and Spanker at 6 A.M. commenced stowing down at 8 set the Jib and Spanker and halled up the fore Spencer S.E. ends Lat by Ob 8-24 Lon 86-50

Remarks on Board Thursday 8

All this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. finished stowing down and took in the Jib and Spanker at 9 A.M. made sail at 10 saw one whale at 11 leaved the Boats S.E. ends in Chase Lat by Ob 7-54 Lon 86-20

Remarks on Board Friday 9

First part of this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. by S and Cloudy weather at 4 the Boats came on Board and the whale went off to the windward. at 6 P.M. shortened sail Middle and Latter parts hit breezes and good weather at 2 A.M. more Ship to the Southward at 6 saw whales at 8 leaved the Boats S.E. ends in Chase Lat by Ob 7-47 Lon 86-00

Remarks on Board Saturday 10

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy at 1 P.M. the Boats came on Board and got up the Chase Breeched full and steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 P.M. took Ship to the Eastward saw Blackfish S.E. ends Lat by Ob 7-37 Lon 85-50
