Commenced cutting at 4 finished cutting the Body and left the Head along side at 8 spoke the Gideon Howland Capt Shearman with 1200 at 8 A.M. Commenced cutting the Head took in the junk and the case work and parted the Reef So Ends employed Brailing and setting up Shooks

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather at 2 P.M. wore Ship to the Southward employed Brailing and setting up Shooks. saw Blackfish Middle and Latter parts the same So Ends

Remarks on Board Saturday 15

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 2 P.M. finished Brailing and Commenced Stowing down

Middle part equally Latter part more moderate employed Stowing down we wore Ship at 6 P.M. to the Eastward saw Blackfish So Ends

Remarks on Board Sunday 16

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward under short sail employed stowing down at 2 P.M. saw one whale. hoard two Boats and the whale went down and we saw none of them. Middle part the wind and weather the same Latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. wore Ship So Ends employed stowing down. one Ship in sight. saw Blackfish

All this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to E.S.E. and Cloudy steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened sail the Gideon Howland in sight at 6 A.M. made sail at 9 wore one whale and the Howland got him So Ends
