First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather. tacked Ship to the Southward. the Gideon Howland in sight employed cutting at 6 P.M. shortened sail. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. set the Hold and made sail at 9 employed starting water to Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 10-18 Lon 87-10

Remarks on Board Tuesdayth 25

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and squally weather. steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail and wore Ship. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail saw Blackfish to Ends So Ob = - Lon 86-45

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 26

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened sail and at 6 A.M. made sail at 9 steaming S.E. saw Blackfish to Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 9-24 Lon 86-20

Remarks on Board Thursdayth 27

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather. wore Ship and steaming West at 6 P.M. shortened sail and buffed by the wind to the S.W. Middle and Latter parts the wind the same the weather squally one Ship in sight to Ends employed repairing sails So Ob = - Lon 87-35

Remarks on Board Fridayth 28

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail saw Blackfish at 6 A.M. made sail saw Blackfish and Finbacks to Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 11-5 Lon 88-20

Remarks on Board Saturdayth 29

All this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to E by S and good weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail and tacked Ship to the Eastward And at 6 A.M. made sail to Ends with A good Lookout. Lat by Ob 10-52 Lon 88-00

Remarks on Board Sunday Decemberth 30-1832

First part of this 24 hours lites breezes from S.W. to S.E. and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened sail and spoke the Gideon Howland and wore Ship and lay the Main Top sail aback at 11 braced full and wore Ship Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy to Ends Lat by Ob 10-24 Lon 87-30

Remarks on Board Mondayth 31

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 9 P.M. shortened sail Blackfish and Porpoises very plenty at 5 A.M. while waiting the Hold saw one whale at 7 boarded the Boats and got him to Ends employed cutting Lat by Ob 10-00 Lon 86-45

Remarks on Board Tuesday Januaryth 1 1833

First part of this 24 hours lites breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. finished cutting and made sail steaming by the wind to the Eastward. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. wore Ship and set the fly jib and Main Top Gallant sail to Ends employed Brailing Lat by Ob 10-3 Lon 86-40

Remarks on Board Wednesdayth 2

First part of this 24 hours lites breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Southward employed Brailing at 6 P.M. took in the fly jib and Main Top Gallant sail and wore Ship Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. finished Brailing and made all sail saw Blackfish to Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 9-47 Lon 86-20

Remarks on Board Thursdayth 3

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. took in the Fore and Main Top Gallant sail and fly jib Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. tacked Ship to the Southward to Ends employed setting up Shooks and doing other necessary jobs Lat by Ob 9-28 Lon 85-45
