First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.S.E. and good weather steering by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. saw the Land and took in the Four and Mizen Top Gallant sail and fly jib Middle and Latter parts moderate breezes at S.S.E. with some fog. steering S by E at 2 A.M. made sail at 11 noon Ship and Bunt the Cable at 10 noon the Land 3 Miles distant. So Ends

Remarks on Board Wednesday #16

First part of this 24 hours of light breezes at S.S.E. and good weather more Ship and stood to the Bay of Santa and the Capt. took the Boat and rounded and served the Anchorage but did not think it fit for the Ship to lay there and came on Board And more Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter part light breezes at 10 A.M. spoke the Ship Mountreimann Capt Coffin no Lil So Ends with Ship's Duty the Land 12 Leagues Dist

Remarks on Board Thursday #17

All this 24 hours light breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. and pleasant weather. steering by the wind to the Southward at 8 P.M. parted with the Mountreimann. we swept four bundles of slim Hoops with Capt Coffin for the same number of straight ones. at 8 A.M. unbent the Cable and stowed it away So Ends employed cleaning the Chain

First part of this 24 hours light breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. and pleasant weather. backed Ship to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 10 A.M. backed Ship saw Blackfish and Humpbacks the Land 10 Leagues Dist

First part of this 24 hours light breezes from S.E. to South. And pleasant weather at 2 P.M. backed Ship to the Eastward at 10 P.M. more Ship. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. more Ship to the Eastward So Ends with Ship's Duty

First part of this 24 hours light breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. and pleasant weather at 5 P.M. more Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. more Ship to the Eastward at 8 more Ship to the Southward and at 10 more Ship to the Eastward one Brig in sight So Ends the Land 10 Leagues Dist

Remarks on Board Monday #21

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at S.S.E. and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. more Ship to the Southward at 11 more Ship to the Eastward at 2 A.M. more Ship to the Southward at 4 backed Ship to the Eastward at 9 thick of fog backed Ship and lay the Main Yard aback and Bunt the Cable at 10 the fog lifted more Ship and stood in but could not fetch the Harbor So Ends one Brig in Company Breasting in to Guernsey

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S by E and pleasant weather at 5 P.M. came to Anchor in the Harbor of Guernsey in 8 fathoms water Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. sent one half the Crew on shore on Liberty And the remainder employed painting Tarring and getting of Bitum And Pumpkins So Ends

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather one half the Crew on shore on Liberty and the remainder employed painting and other necessary jobs So Ends

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather one half on Shore on Liberty and the remainder of the Crew employed in Ship's Duty So Ends

Remarks on Board Friday #25

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather one half the Crew on Shore and the remainder employed scraping and blacking the Bands and other necessary jobs So Ends
