

Remarks on Board Saturday January 26 - 1839

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather one half the crew on Shore on Liberty and the remainder employed in Ship's Duty at Sunset the Boat went on Shore After the Liberty men and David Thurston and Thomas Brach were missing at Sunrise the Boat went on Shore after them And found David Thurston and he damaged ginseng on Board And abused the Capt for which he was taken on Board and put in Irons for the space of three hours at 10 AM the Boat went on Shore and found Thomas Brach very much intoxicated And took him on Board So Ends

Remarks on Board Sunday 27

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at 8 AM by S and good weather at 2 PM took the Anchor and made sail and left the Harbor of Governor. steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 PM got the Anchors stowed and the cable hauled down And all sail set to the best advantage. Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 8 AM killed a Bull So Ends employed making fish Beef. Lat by Ob 10-39 Lon 77-31

Remarks on Board Monday 28

All this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to S.W. by S and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Southward with all sail set to the best advantage. saw Blackfish So Ends at noon one Ship in sight. Lat by Ob 11-23 Lon 78-15

Remarks on Board Tuesday 29

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 2 PM saw Breaches to wind ward at 3 PM tacked Ship but saw nothing at 4 PM one Ship in sight at 6 tacked Ship Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 8 AM tacked Ship at 9 spoke the Barque Elizabeth of Sam Bedford Capt Sanford. 7 Months out no Lil So Ends Lat by Ob 11-57 Lon 80-20

Remarks on Board Wednesday 30

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and good weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward the Elizabeth in Company at 2 PM finished Repairing the Main Top sail and Bent him at 6 shortened sail Middle and Latter part the wind And weather the same at 8 AM made sail saw Blackfish So Ends the Elizabeth in sight No Ob = Lon 79-15

Remarks on Board Thursday January 31 - 1839

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes from S.E. to S.W. and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward two Ships in sight at 10 PM tacked Ship Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 8 AM tacked Ship And at 10 tacked again saw Blackfish So Ends No Ob. Lon 80-30

Remarks on Board Friday Feb 1

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 PM tacked Ship to the Eastward Middle and Latter parts moderate breezes at 8 PM by S and good weather So Ends with ships Duty at 11 AM tacked Ship the Land in sight Lat by Ob 10-57 Lon 78-35

Remarks on Board Saturday 2

All this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to S.W. by S and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Southward employed Taving down the Rigging and Painting. saw Blackfish Lat by Ob 11-26 Lon 79-30

Remarks on Board Sunday 3

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. by S and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Southward Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 2 AM tacked Ship to the Eastward saw Killen's and Blackfish So Ends Lat by Ob 11-52 Lon 79-55

Remarks on Board Monday 4

All this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 8 AM met the Hble. one Ship in sight at 11 Spoke the Ship Boneditch Capt Gardner 6 Months out with 200. So Ends employed Taving down Lat by Ob 11-38 Lon 79-15

Remarks on Board Tuesday 5

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. by S and pleasant weather. more Ship to the Southward the Boneditch in Company at 10 PM parted with the Boneditch. Middle and Latter part moderate breezes from S.E. to S.W. and pleasant weather at noon tacked Ship to the Eastward So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 12-30 Lon 79-15
