steering by the wind to the Eastward employed on the  
Rigging saw Timberacks So Ends Lat by Ob 12-7 Lon 78-50

Remarks on Board Thursday 7<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and  
pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Eastward  
at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter  
the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. steering West  
employed getting up A new Fore Stay at Noon saw Blackfish  
So Ends Lat by Ob 12-15 Lon 79-10

Remarks on Board Friday 8<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant  
weather steering West at 1 P.M. saw whales to windward  
buffed by the wind at 2 tacked Ship to the Eastward and  
loosed the B.Boats and got two. Middle and Latter part  
the wind and weather the same at 5 A.M. Commenced  
Cutting. saw Blackfish So Ends Lat by Ob 11-58 Lon 79-20

Remarks on Board Saturday 9<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant  
weather at 2 P.M. finished Cutting and Commenced B.Boats  
at half past five saw one whale along way of. made  
sail and steering by the wind to the Eastward at midnight  
saw Ship Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather  
the same employed B.Boats and setting up Shocks So Ends  
Lat by Ob 11-52 Lon 79-15

Remarks on Board Sunday 10<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant  
weather steering by the wind to the Southward Middle  
and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 5 A.M.  
saw Ship So Ends employed B.Boats Lat by Ob 12-21 Lon 79-25

Remarks on Board Monday 11<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good  
weather steering by the wind to the Eastward at 5 P.M. saw  
one whale loosed but could not strike came on Board and wore  
Ship at 6 finished B.Boats Middle and Latter part the wind and  
weather the same at 2 A.M. wore Ship at 7 made sail So Ends employed  
steering down Lat by Ob 12-4 Lon 79-5

Remarks on Board Tuesday February 12<sup>th</sup> 1833  
First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to S.W. and good  
weather steering by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened  
sail and wore Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter part the  
wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. after setting the Hold made  
sail So Ends with Ships Duty the Cooper setting up Shocks  
Lat by Ob 12-28 Lon 79-30

Remarks on Board Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good  
weather steering by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened  
sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same  
at 2 A.M. wore Ship at 6 A.M. Commenced Coopersing the Hold  
in order for stowing down at 11 got ready and began stowing  
saw Timberacks So Ends Lat by Ob 12-38 Lon 79-5

Remarks on Board Thursday 14<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant  
weather steering by the wind to the Eastward employed stowing  
down at 1 P.M. saw whales at 2 part of and got one and took  
him along side. and continued stowing down Middle and  
Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M.  
Commenced Cutting and at Noon finished So Ends one Ship in  
sight Lat by Ob 12-15 Lon 79-00

Remarks on Board Friday 15<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to S.W.  
and pleasant weather. at 3 P.M. wore Ship to the Southward  
employed B.Boats Middle and Latter part the wind and  
weather the same at 7 A.M. tacked Ship at 8 spoke the  
Ship Capharnates Capt Howland all full So Ends  
Lat by Ob 12-29 Lon 79-15

Remarks on Board Saturday 16<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and pleasant  
weather steering by the wind to the Eastward the Capharnates  
In Company at 5 P.M. went on Board the Capharnates and got  
six small Cask of Water and six B. Bundles of Iron Hooks three  
hundred Brevets. at 6 wore Ship at 11 finished B.Boats Middle  
and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 5 A.M. wore  
Ship at 7 made sail at Noon two Ships in sight So Ends  
Lat by Ob 12-28 Lon 78-55
