First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. to S.W. and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. shortened sail and tacked Ship one Ship in sight Middle and Latter part lite breezes and pleasant at 6 A.M. commenced Coopersing and at 10 commenced stowing down So Ends

Remarks on Board Tuesday 19

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shorten sail finished stowing down and tacked Ship Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 7 A.M. after making the Hald wore Ship and made sail So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 12-28 Lon 79-10

Remarks on Board Wednesday 20

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 1 P.M. saw whales loared and got one at 5 commenced Cutting Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 5 A.M. commenced Cutting again at 6 saw whales loared and got one and got a Boat badly stove So Ends employed Cutting

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. employed Cutting at 6 P.M. finished Cutting the Bodeys and one of the Heads and commenced Boiling Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same all hands employed Cutting, Coopersing, and Boiling, starting Bread and other necessary jobs Lat by Ob 11- Lon 78-45

Remarks on Board Friday February 22-1833

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather at 2 P.M. got there with the Head and made sail at 6 wore Ship to the Southward employed Boiling Middle and Latter part the same So Ends So Ob = Lon 79-15

Remarks on Board Saturday 23

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Southward employed Boiling Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. finished Boiling, and wore Ship to the Eastward at 8 A.M. made sail So Ends

Lat by Ob 11-51 Lon 78-45

Remarks on Board Sunday 24

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather, steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 2 P.M. two Ships in sight at 4 tacked Ship at 6 spoke Coy Capt Spooner and Charles Capt Rutchard of London Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward So Ends

Lat by Ob 11-20 Lon 79-5

Remarks on Board Monday 25

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 8 P.M. tacked Ship and took in the Main Top Gallant sail Middle part the same Latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. after making the Hald commenced Coopersing and stowing down at 9 wore Ship to the Eastward So Ends Lat by Ob 11-20 Lon 78-50

Remarks on Board Tuesday 26

First part of this 24 hours lite breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather, steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. tacked Ship at 6 set the Main sail. Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 8 oon finished stowing down saw 2 Blackfish So Ends

Lat by Ob 12-15 Lon 79-35

Remarks on Board Wednesday 27

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. tacked Ship and set the Main sail Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail saw 2 Blackfish So Ends with Ships Duty
