

Remarks on Board Thursday February 28 - 1833

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward At 6 P.M. tacked Ship and spoke the Gideon Howland Capt. Sherman with 1000. Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same saw Blackfish to Ende Lat by Ob 12-12 Lon 79-30

Remarks on Board Friday March 1st

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. with the squalls of Rain at 2 P.M. tacked Ship and hauled up the main sail and four and Main Spencer Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. wore Ship to the Eastward and split the jib at 6 unlashed him and repaired him at 11 Bristled the Fore and Main Top sail at Noon Bristled the jib and set him to Ende Lat by Ob 12-12 Lon 79-00

Remarks on Board Saturday 2nd

First part of this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. and equally at 6 P.M. shortened sail and wore Ship to the Southward Middle part the same Latter part more moderate At 6 A.M. made sail at 7 wore Ship and steaming S.E. to Ende with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 12-38 Lon 78-45

Remarks on Board Sunday 3rd

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. steaming S.E. at 6 P.M. shortened sail and wore Ship Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. wore Ship at 6 made sail to Ende with a good lookout. Lat by Ob 12-24 Lon 78-30

Remarks on Board Monday 4th

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward At 6 P.M. shortened sail and wore Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. after meeting the F.D. made sail and steaming West saw one Finback to Ende Lat by Ob 12-28 Lon 79-15

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 5th - 1833

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather. steaming West at 6 P.M. shortened sail and wore Ship to the Eastward Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 6 A.M. made sail at 8 A.M. commenced breaking out and Coopering the Oil from between Decks to Ende Lat by Ob 12-10 Lon 78-40

Remarks on Board Wednesday 6th

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward employed Coopering at 6 P.M. wore Ship Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. saw whales at 8 hauled and chased until Noon but could not get fast so came on Board to Ende Lat by Ob 12-10 Lon 79-00

Remarks on Board Thursday 7th

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Southward employed Coopering and stowing down at 6 P.M. saw whales to windward & breaching at 5 took out one Lump and lifted the other and cleaned the Wellbore out and made a passage for the water Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 12 tacked Ship at Noon finished stowing down to Ende saw Blackfish Lat by Ob 12-30 Lon 78-50

Remarks on Board Friday 8th

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. and Cloudy. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 2 P.M. saw whales to windward stood along one half hour and tacked Ship and the whales went off to windward. Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 10 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward at 8 A.M. made all sail to Ende with Ship's Duty Lat by Ob 12-23 Lon 78-20

Remarks on Board Saturday 9th

First part of this 24 hours light breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. shortened sail. Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 10 A.M. tacked Ship to the Southward the Land in sight saw Blackfish to Ende Lat by Ob 12-17 Lon 79-45
