First part of this 24 hours lites breezes from S.E. to S.W. and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. tacked Ship and shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. made sail. saw Blackfish So Ends Lat by Ob 12-37 Lon 78-45

Remarks on Board Friday th 22

All this 24 hours lites breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. steaming S.W. at 6 P.M. took in the Top Gallant sails and ~~the~~ Jib and at 8 A.M. set them again So Ends Employed Repairing a Boat and other necessary jobs Lat by Ob 12-18 Lon 79-20

Remarks on Board Saturday th 23

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. steaming by the wind to the Southward at 6 P.M. tacked Ship Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same finished Repairing the Boat So Ends with Ships Duty Lat by Ob 13-00 Lon 78-25

Remarks on Board Sunday th 24

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to the ~~S~~ Southward Middle and Latter the wind and weather the same at 2 A.M. tacked to the Eastward at Noon saw a Brig standing to the S.W. So Ends Lat by Ob 12-48 Lon 79-15

Remarks on Board Monday th 25

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 8 tacked Ship to the Southward Middle and Latter part the same at 2 A.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward So Ends employed Cleaning Ship. Lat by Ob 12-21 Lon 79-20

Remarks on Board Tuesday th 26

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather steaming by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. tacked Ship the Land in sight. lay of and on threw the Light at 8 A.M. made all sail and got ready to come to Anchor So Ends Lat by Ob 12-4 Lon 79-5

Remarks on Board Wednesday March th 27-1832

First part of this 24 hours lites breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather beating in to the Harbor of Callao sea port of Lima was Boarded by the Capt of the Boat and the Regenerator Demanded at 6 P.M. came to Anchor in 5 1/2 fathoms water Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. employed getting the Cask ready for water at 8 sent the Craft of Cask on Shore and at Noon got the Craft on Board So Ends Employed scraping and Cleaning the Boards in order for Painting

Remarks on Board Thursday th 28

First part of this 24 hours lites breezes and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. got of the recent Craft of water Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. sent one half the Crew on Shore on Liberty So Ends with Ships Duty in the Harbor of Callao

Remarks on Board Friday th 29

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. the English Frigate Dublin came to Anchor at 6 sent the Boat on Shore for the Liberty men and they all came on Board excepting two Thomas Francis and James Cunningham Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. the other watch went on Shore on Liberty and the remainder of the Crew employed getting of Potatoes and other necessary jobs So Ends

Remarks on Board Saturday th 30

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. sent the Boat on Shore for the Liberty men and they came on Board and James Cunningham with them but Thomas Francis refused to come on Board and sent a Letter to Capt Cleveland at 8 A.M. one watch went on Shore on Liberty and James Cunningham was corrected and sent to his Duty at 10 sent on Shore one Cask of Bread three Casks of Tobacco So Ends with Ships Duty
