employed getting of Potatoes and four Barrels of Beef
And other necessary things. Thomas Francis not on Board
So Ends

Remarks on Board Monday April 1

All this 24 hours lte breezes and pleasant weather
at 6 PM the Liberty men came on Board at 8 AM
Commenced Stowing down water and setting the Hold
And other necessary jobs So Ends at 5 PM Arrived the
English Sloop of War Tins. Thomas Francis not Returned

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 2

All this 24 hours lte breezes and pleasant weather
All Hands employed in Ship's Duty at 10 AM the Ship
Rajah Capt Bennett Arrived with 200 and one Ship
And a number of small Craft left the Harbor So Ends
Thomas Francis not Returned

Remarks on Board Wednesday April 3

All this 24 hours lte breezes and pleasant weather
All hands employed in Ship's Duty accepting three
that is unwell Capt Cleveland has had the Doctor
of the Dolphin on Board and got his Advice concerning
them So Ends

Remarks on Board Thursday April 4

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather
All hands employed in Ship's Duty at 8 AM one watch
went on shore on Liberty So Ends. a number of Brigs and
Schooners passing in and out the Harbor

Remarks on Board Friday April 5

All this 24 hours lte breezes and pleasant weather
one half the crew on Liberty and the remainder
Employed in Ship's Duty at 11 AM the Sloop of War
Tins left the Harbor and N. French Brig Arrived
So Ends

Remarks on Board Saturday April 6 - 1833

All this 24 hours lte breezes and pleasant weather all hands
employed one watch on Liberty and the remainder employed
getting of water at 6 PM the Boat went on Shore for the
Liberty men and three of them stayed on Shore all night
John C. Biddle David Thurston and Thomas Beach
at 11 AM the Boat went on Shore after water and
they came on Board. at Noon got the water on Board and
got ready for Sea So Ends

Remarks on Board Sunday April 7

First part of this 24 hours lte breezes at 8 PM and pleasant
weather at 6 PM took the Anchor and made sail and left
the Harbor of Callao at 8 the Island of Linceo bearing
S. by E. Distance 6 Miles from which I take my Departure
steering N. by W. the Ship Washington and Balena in Company
Middle and Latter part the wind and weather the same
stowed the Anchors and Coiled down the Cables So Ends
Charles Corbet gets unwell and has had the Doctor for
a number of days Lat by Ob 10-4 Lon 77-50

Remarks on Board Monday April 8

First part of this 24 hours lte breezes at 8 PM and pleasant weather
steering N. by W. under short sail the Washington and Balena
in Company at 9 PM buffed by the wind and parted with them
Middle and Latter parts the wind and weather the same at 6 AM
After setting the Hold. we made sail and I by I employed in
Ship's Duty So Ends Lat by Ob 12-36 Lon 78-45

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 9

First part of this 24 hours lte breezes from S. by E. to S. by W.
pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Southward
at 6 PM shortened sail Middle and Latter parts the
wind and weather the same at 6 AM made sail. saw
Blackfish So Ends with Ship's Duty
Lat by Ob 13-8 Lon 79-30
