So at 8 A.M. after mending the Stole made Sail & Ends
Lat by Ob 18-25 Lon 84-40

Remarks on Board Sunday th 14

S.S.E. and pleasant weather at 6 A.M. shortened sail
Middle and Latter part the fresh breezes with some
squalls of Rain at 8 A.M. set the Main Top Gallant sail
and squared the after yards and steaming S.S.W.
So Ends the Sick in a fair way Lat by Ob 19-52 Lon 85-45

First part of this 24 hours strong breezes at S.E. and equally
weather. steaming S.S.W. at 6 A.M. took in the Main Top Gallant
Sail and Reefed the Fore and Main Top Sail Middle and Latter
part the wind and weather the same at 8 A.M. took in the Main
Top sail and sent down the Fore and Main Royal yard and
Mast all hands Employed in Ship's Duty & Ends
Lat by Ob 21-33 Lon 86-49

Remarks on Board Tuesday th 16

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. and Cloudy
weather. steaming S.S.W. under short sail at 8 A.M. equally
took in the Spanker and Fore Spencer Middle and Latter
part more moderate at 6 A.M. set the Main top Sail
Spanker and Spencer & Ends all hands Employed
shifting Sails Lat by Ob 23-28 Lon 88-10

Remarks on Board Wednesday th 17

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. by E and pleasant
weather. steaming S.S.W. at 8 A.M. made sail. all hands
Employed on the Rigging and Sails & Ends with a good
lookout Lat by Ob 25-16 Lon 89-28

Remarks on Board Thursday th 18

All this 24 hours lte breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather
steaming S.S.W. at 6 A.M. saw two whales to wind ward heard two
Boats but could not catch them tacked to the Eastward and
at 6 tacked to the S.S.W. and shortened sail at 8 A.M. made sail
all hands Employed on the Rigging & Ends Lat by Ob 26-5 Lon 90-5

Remarks on Board Friday th 19

All this 24 hours lte breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. and pleasant
weather. steaming S.S.W. when wind enough for the Ship to
steer all hands Employed in Ship's Duty taking in the
Anchors and stowing them fitting 9 fish Stor and other necessary
things. saw 2 Blackfish & Ends Lat by Ob 26-50 Lon 90-38

Remarks on Board Saturday th 20

All this 24 hours lte breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. and pleasant
weather. steaming South with all sail set to the best advantage
all hands Employed on the Rigging at Noon spoke the Ship
Daisy Hall London 32 Months out with 1900 & Ends
Lat by Ob 27-16 Lon 90-45
