Cloast reefs heading to the N.W. Latitude 34° 29'

Saturday 28 wore ship to the west N.W. later part
moderate maid all sail heading N.W.
saw 1 Chaist 1 whale could not pass

& unpleasant weather No observation heading
to the westward

N.W. & first part some rain at 5 P.M.
a heavy squall from N.W. attended with
heavy rain Cloast reft M. 5 sail took in the
foresail saw several whales to rigged to loar
Tuesday at 6 wore ship to the North at 12 wore to
28 the S.W. later part saw several whale Chaist
one without success ends moderate & pleasant
1 ship 15 bargues in sight Latitude 34° 55'

later part lively breezes & fair all sail
Sat standing to the Westward saw nothing
1 Barque in sight Latitude 35° 13'

Longitude at 1 past M. 22° 17' 30"

Thursday 30 first part lively breezes from N.W. & hazy
weather at 2 P.M. backed ship to the N.E. spoke
Barque Manmoth Goodwin Plymouth 2 whale
middle part strong breezes & squally ends with
lively breezes from N.W. & pleasant & sail in
sight our ship with all sail set standing to
the N.W. Latitude by Obs 34°
