left of West Cleared away & washt off at 4  
Started the works Steered W. & W. under short  
Sail through the night in the morning Lat  
Double reef & Steered W. & W. wind E. Lat

 that quarter at 9 distant thunder. Double reef. 1 x. Close reef  
 main. 1 sails fild. M. sail & gill. at 10 heavy thunder. Long 35.  
 & sharp lightning. Close reef. M. T. sail. Cleared up. F. K. M. & hallad. 1 x.  
 1 sail & the cloud burst upon us with whistling wind from SW with heavy  
 rain. 1 x. accompanied with heavy thunder & chain lightning. East 31.  
 at Double reef. Ends with strong breezes south.
