

Monday June 15<sup>th</sup> 1840

All these 24 hours light SE winds from & fine weather at 12 PM ticked to the SW saw 14 number of ships but no whales  
Latitude 24° 34'

Longitude at 3 PM 109° 44'

Tuesday 16

All these 24 hours light breezes from from SE to East & fine weather first part steered to the SW by the wind at sunset spoke English whale ship Recovery 4 months from Landan 10 bbls & Barque Waterwatch 4 months out no oil middle part steered SW under double reefs later steered N SW  
Latitude 25° 11'

Wednesday 17

First part of these 24 hours light breezes from East to ESE & fine steered West lanced 1 large sulphur bottom whale & spouted light blue oil up a pretty shine middle fine breeze from ESE stood to the south under single reefs later fresh from SE at 8 steered SW in company with ship Lucy Ann  
Latitude 25° 04'

Thursday 18

All these 24 hours fresh gales from SE & some squally first part steered SW middle to SW later under double reefs the sea rough  
Latitude 24° 09'

Friday 19

All these 24 hours strong gales from SE by E & flying clouds started to the SW by the wind in sight of Lucy Ann saw nothing but pinpoints  
Latitude 23° 20'

Saturday 20

All these 24 hours strong gales from SE to ESE & hazy weather standing to the SW under short sail sea rough all hands well  
Latitude 23° 04'

Sunday June 21 - 1840

All these 24 hours strong gales from SE & clear sea rough at 4 PM wore ship to SW under short sail all these 24 hours  
Latitude 23° 06'

Monday 22

First part of these 24 hours strong gales from ESE & clear middle more moderate later lively from East standing to SE under 3 sails & courses  
Latitude 23° 49'

Tuesday 23

First part light winds from East & fine sent down mizen T. sail yard & fish it sent it aloft again at 4 lowered for 2 large whales could not pass middle & later small breezes & calm standing to the south  
Latitude 24° 03'

Wednesday 24

First part lively breezes from SW & fair steered SE at sunset double reef later strong squalls with rain wind backing at 10 double reef saw 1 ship to windward cutting  
Latitude 24° 28'

Thursday 25

First part strong gales from ESE & hard squalls attended with rain at 4 PM wore ship to south under double reefs middle & later flying clouds at 7 PM wore to SW rough sea  
Latitude 24° 44'

Friday 26

All these 24 hours fresh gales from ESE & flying clouds at 7 PM wore ship to south one ship in sight but no whales  
Latitude 24° 19'
