

Remarks on Board Ship Leonidas

Monday July 27th 1840

First & middle part light breezes of. Shear later lively along the Shear we high about 34 of 40 mile from shore all hands employed in sundry spread awnings broke out & fitted water casks for rafting. So Ends this day civil account

Tuesday 28

First part light middle fresh breezes all hands employed in ship's duty got of 75 bbls water & stowed it down & coopered the most of our Breeds

Wednesday 29

All this day fine weather wind as usual at night light & calm & strong by day. Lark watch went ashore on liberty. All employed in sundry gabs

Thursday 30

All this day fine weather & strong trades at daylight took our anchor & warped near in Shear. Lark watch on liberty. Lark got of 40 rpts of water 55 bbls & sundry other gabs

Friday 31st

All this day fine weather all hands employed in stowing down water Breeds & C. Cleared & washed the lower deck. A considerable trade of today in the Coconuts such as fruits Eggs potatoes Cucumbers & some other tropical fruits

Saturday Aug 1st

All this day light breezes & fine weather Lark watch on liberty. Lark employed in painting the Bows & iron work & sundry other gabs

Sunday 2nd

All this day weather fine middle part strong breezes from SSE. Lark watch on liberty. L. H. employed in sundry gabs. Sailed Ship Brunswick

Monday 3

All this day fine weather Lark watch on liberty. Lark employed in ship's duty. A English whale came in

Tuesday 4

All this day fine weather middle strong breezes first & later small breezes Lark watch on liberty. Lark employed in ship's duty. Barre harvest Sailed

Loughing in Ampanam bay Linnoc

Wednesday Aug 5th 1840

All this day clear & pleasant weather Lark watch on liberty. Lark employed in sundry gabs of ships

Thursday 6

All this day fine weather middle fresh breezes first & later light & calm. English merchant Barque arrived from Copang. Lark watch on liberty

Friday 7

All this day fine weather wind as usual Lark watch on liberty. The rest on ship's duty. The English merchant Barque Rager arrived

Saturday 8

First part of this day light breezes from SSE. Middle from the westward later light & calm. Lark watch on liberty

Sunday 9th

First part light breezes from SSE. Middle lively from WNW & same Cloudy later light air & calm. Lark watch on liberty

Monday 10

First part calm middle small breezes from the westward later from SSE & calm. Lark watch on liberty. Lark employed in sundry gabs of ships duty. Sailed Ships Hascqua, Delgas, Mayflower & Condore. Long at 5:30 PM by Chro 115° 39' 45"

Tuesday 11

First & later part of this day light breezes from SSE & fine weather. Middle part from the westward. Lark watch on liberty. Lark employed in ship's duty

Wednesday 12th

First part small breezes middle fresh from SSE later light & clear & pleasant weather. Lark watch on liberty

Thursday 13th

All this day fine weather & fine breezes all hands employed in ship's duty. Went ashore & got 5 bbls of Sand. Sailed Ship Brighton & Barque Hope on a Cruise

Friday 14

First & later part of this day light breezes middle fresh breezes & flying Clouds all hands employed in ship's duty. Got of 40 bbls of water stowed it down. Set up head rigging & sundry other gabs
