Monday Oct 26th 1840

All these 24 hours fresh breezes from SSW to South first part too halde the case & hane in the junk middle middle middle later cut in the whale at 7
9th more ship & cut to leeward

All these 24 hours moderate breezes from SSW & fine stood to SSW
Employed in hauling Lat

29° 15'

Wednesday 28

All these 24 hours moder breezes from SSW & fair at 4 P.M. more ship to SSW Employed in hauling Latitude 29° 45'

Thursday 29

All these 24 hours strong breezes from SSW & flying claudes & same equally Employed in hauling Latitude 29° 47'

Friday 30

All these 24 hours fresh gales from South & fair first part stowed down about 10 bells middle finisht hauling

Saturday 31st

Long at 3 P.M.

110° 14'

All these 24 hours strong breezes from SSW to SE & fair with rough sea stood to SSW later all hands employed in stowing down in main hale

Sunday November 1st

First part strong breezes from SSW & fair all hands employed in stowing down at 7 finisht stood to SSW by the wind later moderate at 7 M.M. more ship to the East ends fine & pleasant under all sail but no whales

First part fine breezes & fine weather middle & later fresh & fair steered to the Eastward by the wind saw nothing

All these 24 hours strong S.W. winds & flying claudes under double reefs & starboard tacks aboard saw 2 humpbacks anhent & bent
A new gill causer repairing casks we finde it strong current to SE by observations

Wednesday 4

All these 24 hours strong winds from South & SE flying claudes & rough sea at 6.30 P.M. more ship to SSW took in sail first & later under double reefs

Latitude 29° 42'

Long at 5 P.M. 110° 34'

Thursday 5th

All these 24 hours strong breezes from S.W. & flying claudes & rough sea stood to SSW under double reefs saw nothing

Latitude 30° 09'

Friday 6th

Long at 3 P.M. Chron. 109° 56'

All these 24 hours fresh gales from South flying claudes & rough sea at 6.30 more ship later anhent M. I. sail to repair & set double reef

Latitude 29° 56'

Saturday 7

Long at 4 P.M. 110° 57'

All these 24 hours fresh gales from South to SSW flying claudes & rough sea first part employed repairing M. I. sail & bent same at 7 took in sail more ship to SSW later set double reefs at 10 took in sail

Latitude 29° 40'

Sunday 8

First & middle of these 24 hours fresh gales from South & fair later more moderate set double reefs steered to SSW by the wind but no whales to be seen

Latitude 30° 25'

Monday 9

Long at 2 30 P.M. 119° 12'

First part strong breezes from South at 7 more ship to SE later more moderate under all sail watch employed in sundry galy about the rigging but no whales
