

Remarks on Board Ship Leonid

Saturday 23th

First and later of this day light breezes from S to South Middle Calm Clear and very warm all hands Employed in cutting and boating wood and Cooper setting up shooks for water at 2 P.M. got all the wood on board and cleared the decks

Sunday 24

First part lively breezes from South Middle and later strong breezes and clear at 6 A.M. got under way and went 12 miles farther up the Bay to leave where there is a few settlers for vegetables went to shore and got a few Cabbage sprouts and a few turnups which cost enormous price got one bucket of potatoes for each ship

Arrived Ship Barclay & B. Mary D. Candore D. and Newark of Loukepsie

Monday 25

First part fresh breezes from South Middle light and hailing later fresh from S.W. to South and clear weather all hands Employed in ships duty cleared and commenced painting Cooper setting up shooks for water

Tuesday 26

All this day light breezes from S.W. to South and fine weather at 6 A.M. got under way in company with ship Hercules at 5 P.M. came to anchor in Port Lakenale with best bower anchor and 40 fath Chane rafted and sent ashore 100 bls Cask for water

Wednesday 27

First part Moderate middle and later strong and fair all hands Employed in ships duty working out & Coopering heat 4 men at shore filling water Arrived Ship Barclay

Leighing at Anchor in Port Lakenale

Thursday January 28th 1840

First and middle of this day moderate breezes from South to S.E. and fine weather all hands Employed in ships duty working out & stanning down got off 100 bls water later strong breezes Arrived Ship Friendship Fairhaven Mary Michel Wantusket

Friday 29th

All this day moderate breezes from land and sea & fine weather watch Employed in ships duty stanned down 100 bls water and finesht stanning Promisano sent 80 bls of Cask ashore to fill Starboard watch Mahon on Liberty

Saturday 30th

First part strong breezes from South and fine middle Calm later fresh from South Lark watch on liberty Starb. Employed in ships duty got off 80 bls water and stanning other gals Samuel Haldrege did not return

Sunday 31st

All this day lively and strong breezes from South to East & fine weather Starb. watch on liberty 4 men have run away

Monday February 1st

All this day strong breezes from South & S.E. and fine weather Lark watch on liberty the remainder of the Starb. employed in ships duty painted Lark. bents stanned down same water &c the above 4 men have not returned

Tuesday 2nd

First part lively breezes from South Middle moderate later strong Starb. watch on liberty Lark Employed in ships duty Harnessed Main J.G. Mast put on new rigging sent it up again sent up 2 & 3 x 2 L.G. yards and all 5 x 2 x 1 masts Shift one man from Shore
