

Remarks on Board Ship

Friday March 12 - 1841

All these 24 hours Moderate breezes from South to SW and fine weather at 2:30 took the whale along side at 3:30 Commenced cutting at later finesht Latitude 28°41'

Saturday 13 Long at 3 P. merid 109°38'
First part lively breezes from SW & fine steered to SE by the wind All hands Employed in cutting up junk Clearing away gun Clearing up SC at 4 Start the works at 6 more ship middle light & bailing breezes & fair at 5 4th wore ship to South later small breezes from WSW to West & very fine under all sail 2 ships in sight bailing saw 4 great number of porpoise Latitude 28°52'

Sunday 14 First part lively breezes from West & NW clear weather steered to SW ship off sea beam Boiling on same tack at sunset part of Merchant barque steering to North at 12 middle part ind shifted to SW with 4 strong breezes at 6 4th wore ship to West set Double reefs strong breeze & rough sea at merid finesht bailing Latitude 29°11'

Monday 15 Long 109°30'
All these 24 hours fresh breezes from SE & passing Clouds first & later steered WSW middle headed to SW Latitude 28°52'

Tuesday 16 Long 108°15'
All these 24 hours fresh breezes from South to SE & fair first part steered North middle headed to the Eastward later to WSW by the wind All hands Employed in Hauling down on fore head Latitude 28°21'

Wednesday 17 Long at 4 107°30'

Leonidas of Fairhaven for S. Whales

Wednesday March 17

First & middle fresh breezes from South saw 4 ship to North later strong steered to SW under Double & Close reefs

Thursday 18 Lat 28°39'
Long at 4 107°45'
All these 24 hours strong gales from SE some squally & light showers headed to SW bailing to middle & later parts Latitude 29°05'

Friday 19th All these 24 hours strong gales from SE & squally weather bailing to headed to SW at 6 4th wore ship to East set reef 7th sail

Saturday 20 All these 24 hours strong gales from SE to SW & Mastley Cloudy & rough first part reef foresail set middle bailing to later under Close reefs headed to SE & SE First part saw 4 ship steering to North Lat 28°36'

Sunday 21 Long at 3 106°46'
All these 24 hours strong gales from South middle squally with light showers first & later under Close reefs steered to SE nothing in sight so Ends All well Latitude 28°35'

Monday 22nd Long at 3 PM 107°31'
First part fresh breezes from SE & fair middle strong later quite moderate from SE under late 7th sails steered to Eastward under saw nothing Latitude 28°27'

Tuesday 23 Long at 2:30 108°31'
First & middle fresh breezes from SE and fair later strong under Double reefs steered to East saw 4 ship to off sea beam at 10 tacked ship Latitude 28°00'
Long at 2 107°15'
