

Remarks on Board the Brig Leonidas  
Tuesday May the 4<sup>th</sup> 1841

Weighted Anchor with light winds from the  
W. S. W. Wind light and variable let go the Anchor  
Wednesday May the 5<sup>th</sup> weighed Anchor the wind  
light and variable working down the River come  
to Anchor

Thursday May the 6<sup>th</sup> hove up the Anchor  
and worked down to Newport and come to light  
winds and variables squally with Rain

Friday May the 7<sup>th</sup> weighed Anchor at 7 A.M.  
wind W. S. W. at 12 M Point Judith Bore West  
Distance 2 Leagues so Ends this Day  
Lat. By Obs. 41° 16' North

Saturday May the 8<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh Breeze  
from the W. S. W. steering by the wind at 6 P. M. spoke  
the Lagoon of Mattapoiset Bound in 8 months out  
750 Barrels several sail in sight Employed in fitting  
ship and Boats middle part calm and squally from the  
S. E. latter part strong Gale from the North and N. E  
scudding under close Reef top sails and fore sail passed two  
sail sail so Ends
