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Tuesday June the 4th 1841 Commences with light Breeze from the Eastward standing to the N.E. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail and wore ship at 8 A.M. heavy squalls of wind and Rain with Thunder and lightning took in the fore sail and fore top sail and close reef the main top sail and hove to 2 sail in sight so Ends

Wednesday June the 2nd Begins with thick squally weather laying to heading to the Northward at 2 P.M. made sail at sun set shortened sail and wore ship to the Southward wind from the Eastward middle part the same at day light made sail at 8 A.M. tacked to the Northward squally close Reef the top sail two sail in sight so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 31-17 N. Long 78. 23 W

Thursday June the 3rd Commences with squally weather at 2 P.M. made sail without the fore spencer to alter it would not set at sun set shortened sail and wore ship to the Southward at day light made sail at 6 A.M. tacked to the N.E. Employed altering the fore spencer 2 sail in sight so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 31-30 N. Long 78. 22 W

Friday June the 1st Begins with fresh Breezes from the Eastward standing to the Northward at 1 P.M. tacked to the Southward at sun set shortened sail and wore to the Northward middle part the same at day light made sail wore to the Southward finished the fore spencer and bent it two sail in sight so Ends started 1 All of Beef
